Ongoing work being done by the O&E



 Similiar to the requirements for the <u>Community Regional Outreach Pilot</u> <u>Program (CROPP)-FY16</u>, the proposed CROPP FY17 requires an updated Outreach Strategic Plan for each RALO.

Each RALO's Outreach Strategic Plan should explain its FY17 outreach goals and planned expectations so that any selected CROPP activities can be coordinated with the appropriate ICANN Global Stakeholder Engagement teams.

- These plans must also be approved by the ICANN's regional Global Stakeholder Engagement.
- If any RALO wants to apply for CROPP in mid July 2016, it is important to have approved plans in place by June 30 2016 before proposals can be filed in time for mid July 2016.



LACRALO Draft Outreach Strategy for FY17

- A key focus of LACRALO's outreach strategy will be getting organisations to become accredited At-Large Structures (ALSes) from the 12 out of 33 countries in the Latin American and Caribbean (LAC) region that do not have any ALSes. These countries are noted on the LACRALO Dashboard at http://bit.ly/lacralo-dashboard)
- The LACRALO's members from the Outreach and Engagement SC will be maintaining an outreach calendar at http://bitly.com/LAC-Outreach-Calendar to track possible ICT and IG events in those territories without ALSes and regional IG events where persons and/or possible ALSes from those territories are likely to attend. This calendar will be used to identify possible events for CROPP proposals.

Draft LACRALO Outreach Strategy for FY17

- Furthermore, the LACRALO members of the Outreach and Engagement SC will survey possible individuals and/or organisations that would be At-Large candidates in those countries without ALSes. Other ICANN stakeholders (GAC, ccNSO, Fellows) in territories without ALSes would also be consulted to find suitable At-Large candidates.
- Once a sufficient number of individuals/groups are identified, attempts would be made to contact such individuals to invite them to several conference calls to share information about DNS basics, ICANN and ICANN At-Large so that such individuals/groups can join At-Large and/or participate in opportunities offered by ICANN such as the Fellowship programme, the Nextgen programme and applying for ICANN positions via the Nomcom.
- As a pilot program for FY17, the ICANN LAC Strategy will fund two outreach F2F events in the LAC region (one in Latin America, one in the Caribbean) in countries without At-Large Structures. The LACRALO leadership, in coordination with the LAC Global Stakeholder Engagement, will use the Outreach and Engagement SC's survey data of possible At-Large candidates in countries without ALSes to select which countries will have the F2F events. 

Ongoing Work done by the O&E



Submitted a <u>proposal to the At-Large Finance and Budget SC for access by RALOs for funding of local engagement activities</u>:

"Opportunities exist for At-Large members to do local outreach and engagement about ICANN and ICANN policy related issues. The local activities can include local presentations, brown bag lunch topics, local business persons presentations i.e., Kiwanais, Rotary, Professional Women's University Groups, Chamber of Commerce and more. These local groups at the grassroots are looking for professional speakers on a weekly basis and rely on local experts on various topics. They open up opportunities for speaking engagements at minimum cost.

The ALAC requests that each of the five At-large Regional At-Large Organizations (RALO's) are given access up to \$2,000 each for targeted local discretionary funds to permit the local travel, luncheons, displays, graphic and promotional Facebook/Twitter graphics.

For complete transparency and proper oversight, all RALO budget requests will be reviewed through a process defined once funding is approved."



Ongoing Work done by the O&E



- Ongoing collaboration and participation in ICANN's Civil Society approach.
 Our key concerns continue to be:
 - ensuring that the messaging/marketing towards civil society is inclusive towards civil society becoming a member of At-Large, as well as the NCSG
 - coordination with GSE on possible IG/ICT events that would benefit with an At-Large Presence to assist with outreach.
- Work on Outreach and Engagement activities to take place during ICANN56
- Expand the <u>Analysis of the ICANN Fellowship Program</u> to other stakeholders such as GAC and ccNSO.
