# Scope of Work

ITEMS shall conduct an independent review of the At-Large Community as mandated by ICANN Bylaws, to assess effectiveness of:

- (1) improvements resulting from recommendations from the previous Review,
- (2) components of the At-Large Community ALAC, Regional At-Large Organizations (RALOs) and At-Large Structures (ALSes) in accordance with the ICANN-provided objective and quantifiable criteria


The last review focused primarily on the ALAC. While the current Review will cover all components of the At-Large Community, the primary focus will be on the structures not covered by the last review (i.e. RALOs and ALSes).





### Design and Implementation of Global Survey





Our Consultant Team will conduct its online survey to targeted respondents and organizations using a custom developed, Google Forms-based survey tool. This tried and tested, robust, highly versatile and easy to use tool has many advantages. For respondents, it has the advantage of being easily accessible across all operating systems and devices connected to the Internet, fixed and mobile. We will discuss the survey questionnaire with ICANN before distribution.

The extrapolation of results from the survey will serve to highlight and cross analyse opinions expressed and information gathered in a number of ways, e.g. within a single respondent category or across several respondent categories, geographically or according to other variables such as the size of the organization represented by the respondent, type of engagement within ICANN etc.

In addition to a detailed factual report, the results of the survey will be presented using a variety of formats including tables, charts, graphs and maps.
