Q3 FY17 Quarterly Report

Support a Secure, Stable, and Resilient DNS Infrastructure in the MEAC Region

- Conducted/Lead DNSSEC workshops at SANOG 29 and MENOG 17
- Held a DNSSEC roundtable in Dubai, and a DNSSEC/DANE workshops in Istanbul
- To hold DNSSEC workshops in Riyadh (MENOG Roadshow) and in Dubai in May
- To hold a DNSSEC roundtable in Riyadh (MENOG Roadshow)
- Utilized trained trainers at SANOG 29 and MENOG 17, and will utilize one at the Dubai Workshop
- Shared KSK Rollover updates at the Turkey DNS Forum, SANOG 29, and MENOG 17
- Continue to support the TF-AIDN, and to seek new volunteers
- Seeking feedback on DNS related training needs from ccTLDs, IDN ccTLDs, Registries, Registrars
- Checking the need to train more DNSSEC trainers as part of the TtT

Promote a Healthy and Competitive Domain Name Marketplace in the MEAC Region

- Held the 2017 edition of the Turkey DNS Forum
- Organized a media roundtable at the Turkey DNS Forum in February
- Held a workshop for non-techies in Muscat
- Conducted DNS business workshop in Cairo with the DNS-EC
- Seeking feedback from the regional DNS community on their business related training needs for FY18
- Attended; and continue to attend, a good number of regional events to promote ICANN and its work
- Will hold the 4th edition of the ME DNS Forum in Cairo in May
- Will organize a press conference along with the ME DNS Forum in Cairo

Clarify ICANN's Role in an Evolving Internet Ecosystem through Engagement with the MEAC Community

- Held and continue to hold workshops in Tunisia as part of our youth engagement program with CCK
- Held a workshop on Internet Governance with the American University in Cairo and Egypt ISOC Chapter
- Working with the American University in Cairo on an engagement program similar to the one we have with CCK in Tunisia
- Seeking ways to encourage community members to become more involved in ICANN's work
- Seeking ways to work with regional civil society NGOs, and forward planning on this with the SWG and with the CS Engagement team at ICANN
- Seeking feedback from the regional ALSs on their capacity building needs for FY18
