Dependencies between sub-groups

Issue: recommendations from a sub-group may impact the recommendations of another sub-group. EG if the Human Rights sub-group were to recommend that the Ombudsman be responsible for processing Human Rights complaints this would have to be considered by the Ombudsman sub-group prior to it completing its recommendations.

We need to ensure there is a process in place to avoid unexpected impact of recommendations between groups.



ICANN 57 Travel

- Deadline for applications is 23:59 UTC Friday August 12th.
- There is an equivalent of 20 fully funded travel slots.
- The Co-Chairs are automatically eligible for funding (counts vs the 20 slots) and are responsible for the final approval of the travel applications.
- We have received 15 travel applications to date for a variety of funding from 1 night's hotel to a complete package.
- A number of applications are from non-members. The published policy stipulated that travel funding was for members.
