1	Purpose (Article 3)	Article 3 describes the "specific purpose" of PTI as follows: "The specific purpose of the Corporation is to operate exclusively for the benefit of, to perform the functions of, and to carry out the purposes of the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation ("ICANN")."		CWG has advised that the PTI purpose should be modified to be more closely tailored to the anticipated role of PTI. We understand that CWG will propose language. The current PTI purpose language should also be retained because these particular words are required in order for PTI to qualify as a taxexempt entity under IRC §509(a)(3) as a "supporting organization." As a result, we would recommend that the CWG tailored language be included, followed by the required tax language (e.g., "[tailored PTI purpose inserted], in so doing, PTI shall be operated exclusively for the benefit of, to perform the functions of, and to carry out the purposes of ICANN").
