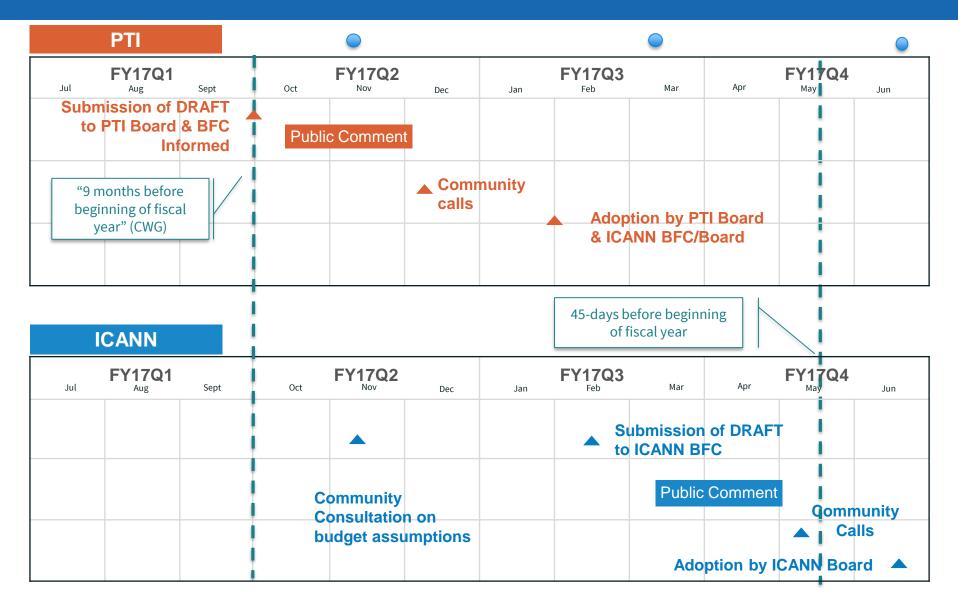
Planning Process Overview

FY18 Planning Calendar – High Level





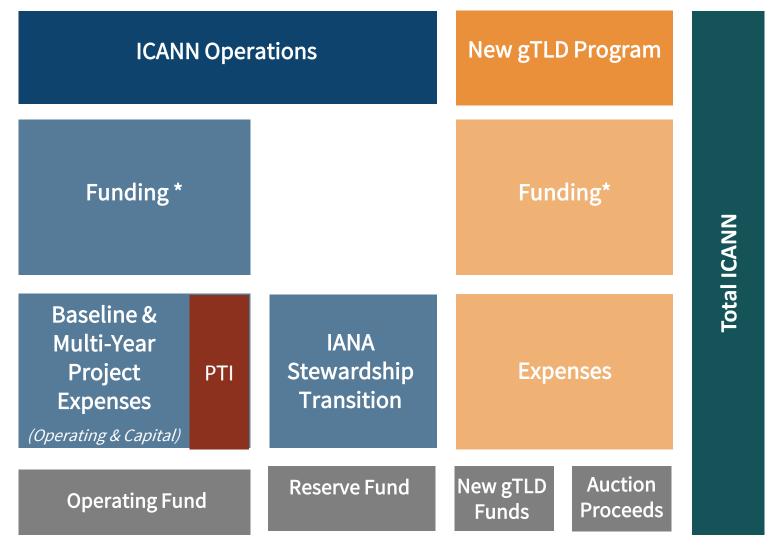

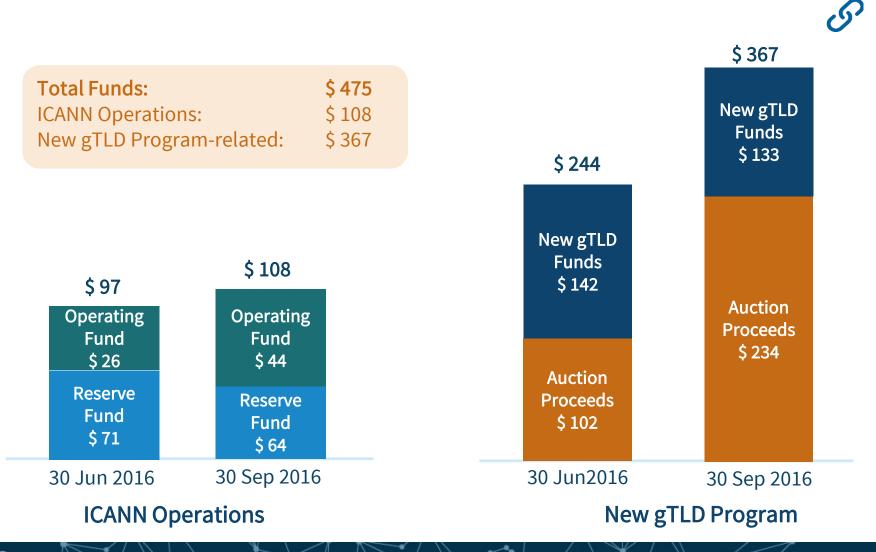

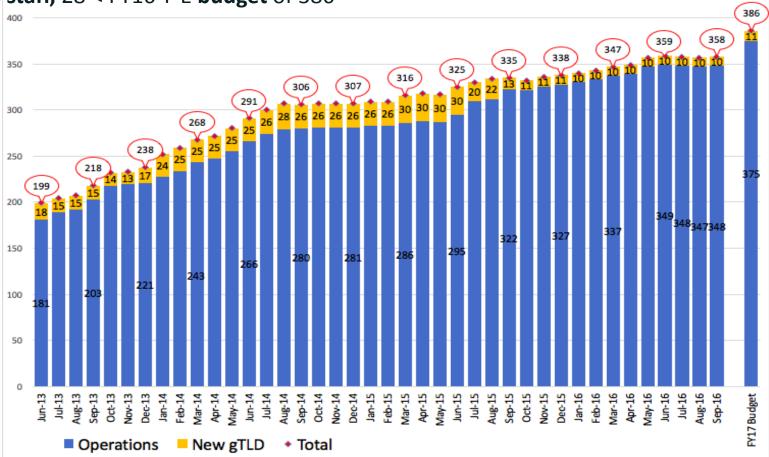

As of the end of September 2016:

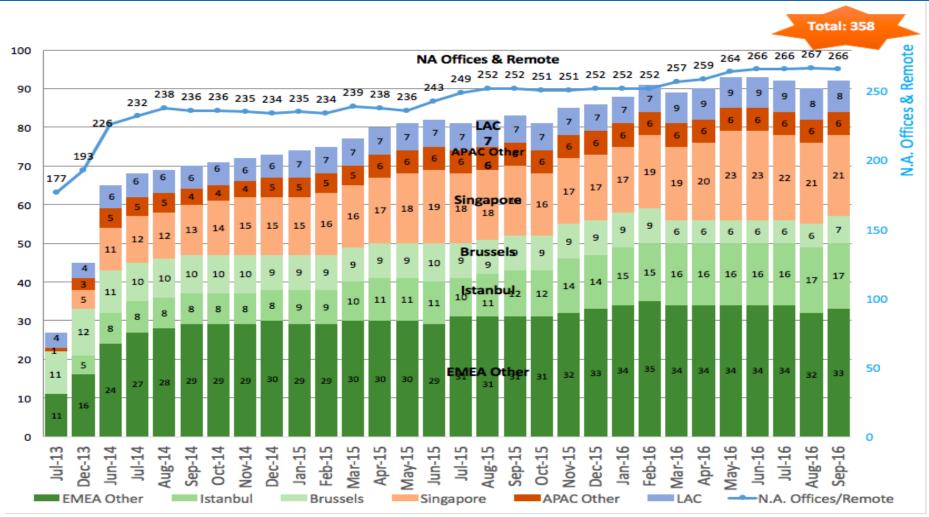
- **358** staff, 28 < FY16 Y-E budget of 386

Organization People – Global Reach

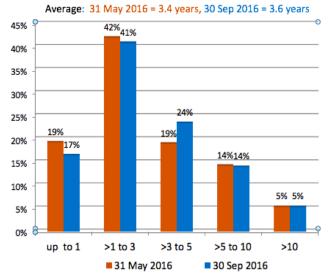


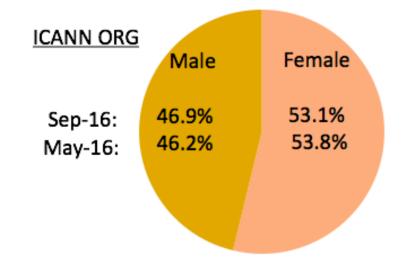

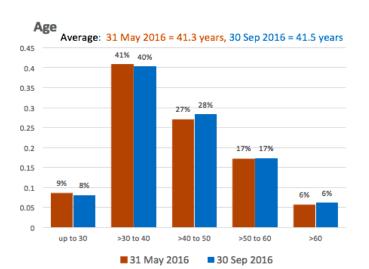


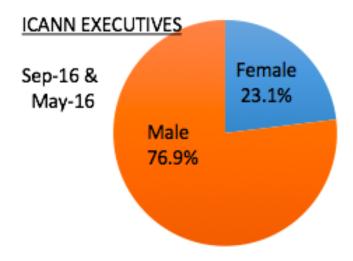
Organization People – Diversity

Years of Service



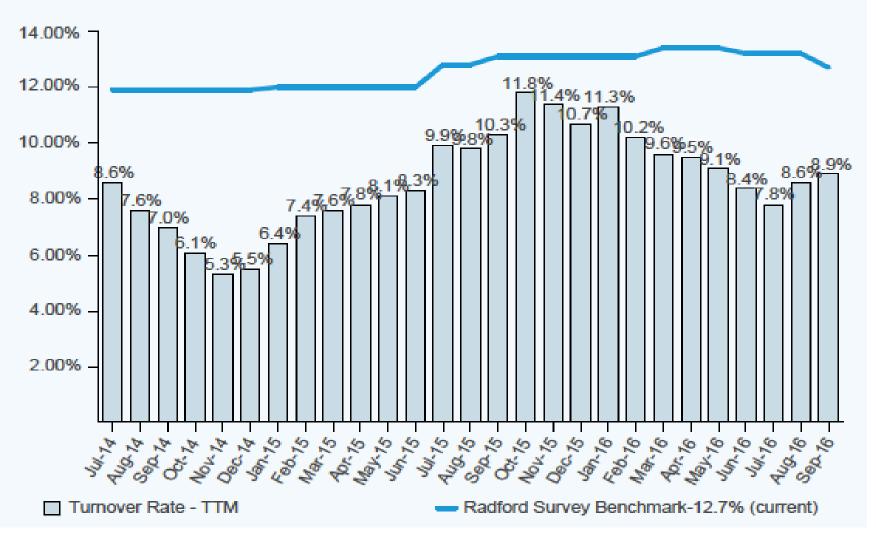






Organization People – Turnover
