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88. Accordingly, the Panel majority declares that in performing its duties of Reconsideration, the BGC must determine whether the CPE (in this case the EIU) and ICANN staff respected the principles of fairness, transparency, avoiding conflicts of interest, and non-discrimination as set out in the ICANN Articles, Bylaws and AGB.

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100 ... ICANN staff was obligated to follow the Articles and Bylaws

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106 ... breach by ICANN staff and the EIU of the transparency obligations found in the Articles , Bylaws, and AGB.

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111..... examine whether the EIU or ICANN staff engaged in unjustified discrimination or failed to fulfill transparency obligations.

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131 Elsewhere in the Bylaws and the Articles of Incorporation, as discussed above, ICANN undertakes general duties of transparency and accountability that are also implicated by !CANN's decision to shield relevant staff work from public disclosure by structuring the staff work to benefit from legal privilege.
