- **Innovation** at “edge”

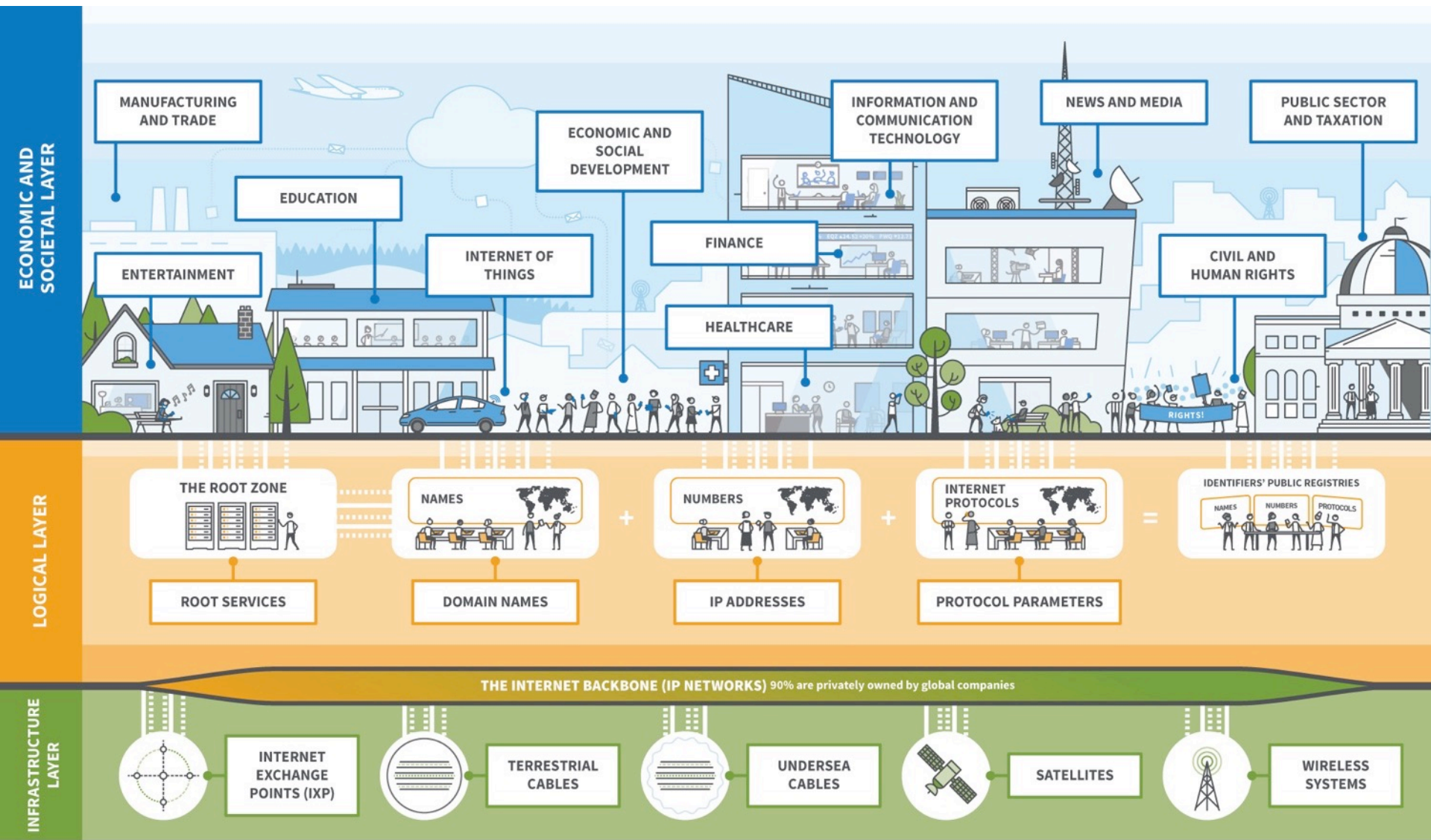
# Components of Internet Ecosystem



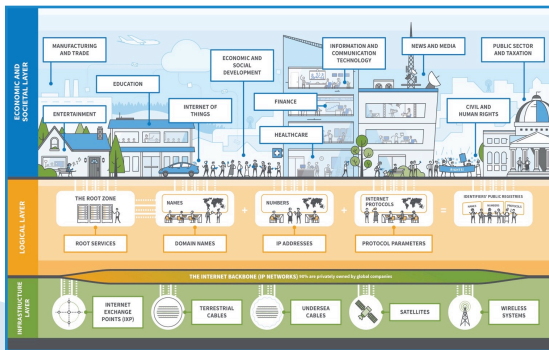
- Internet, a network of networks
- Organizations, individuals and processes that shape the coordination and management of the global Internet
- ICANN is but one of these organizations

# ICANN's modest place in Internet governance

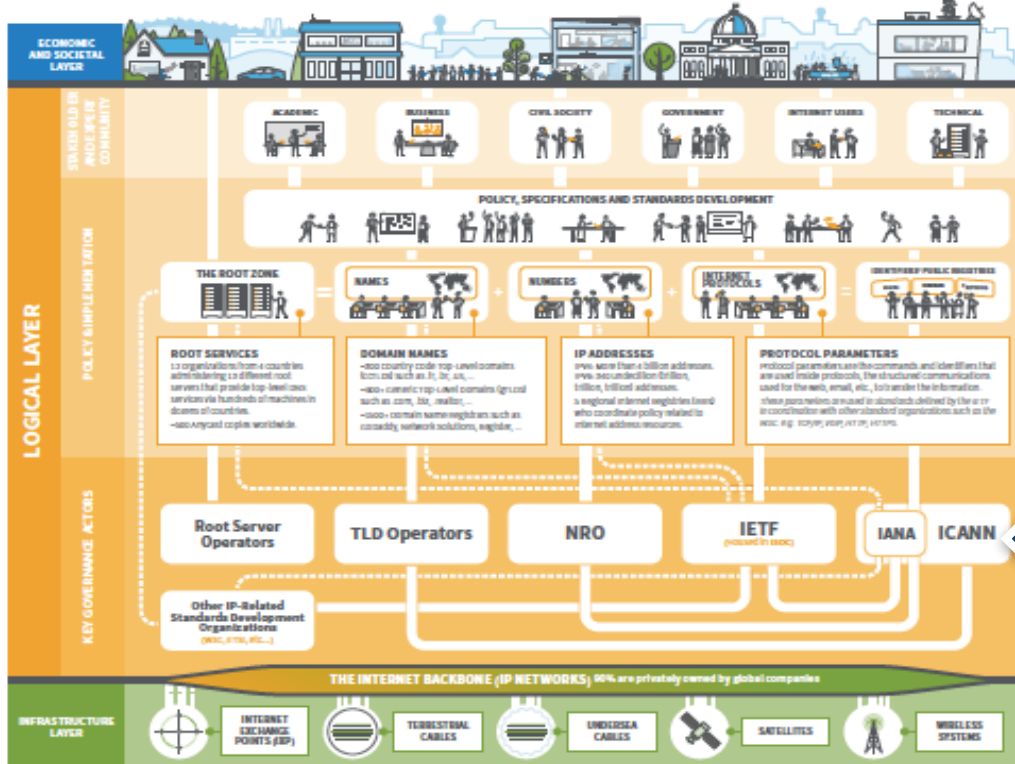

## THE LOGICAL LAYER OF DIGITAL GOVERNANCE

Layered on top of the Physical Infrastructure's thousands of networks and satellites, the Internet's Logical Layer is what delivers One Internet for the world through Unique Identifiers (Names, Numbers, and Protocol Parameters). ICANN coordinates the administration of this layer in partnership with other technical communities to ensure the security, stability, resiliency, and integrity of this critical layer.

# First things first - What does ICANN do?



**The Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN)** is a global multistakeholder, private sector-led organization that manages Internet resources for the public benefit

## WHAT DOES ICANN DO?

To reach another person on the Internet you have to type an address into your device—a name or a number. That address must be unique, so computers will know where to find each other. ICANN maintains and administers these unique identifiers across the world. Without ICANN's management of this system, known as the Domain Name System (DNS), we wouldn't have a global, scalable Internet where we can find each other.

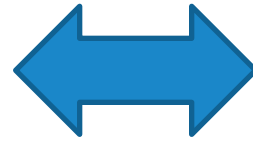

- ⊙ ICANN is best known for its role as the technical coordinator of the Internet's **Domain Name System (DNS)**
- ⊙ ICANN is responsible for coordination of the global internet's unique identifiers; to ensure secure and stable operation of these systems
- ⊙ The set of unique identifier systems coordinated by ICANN are the **IANA functions**

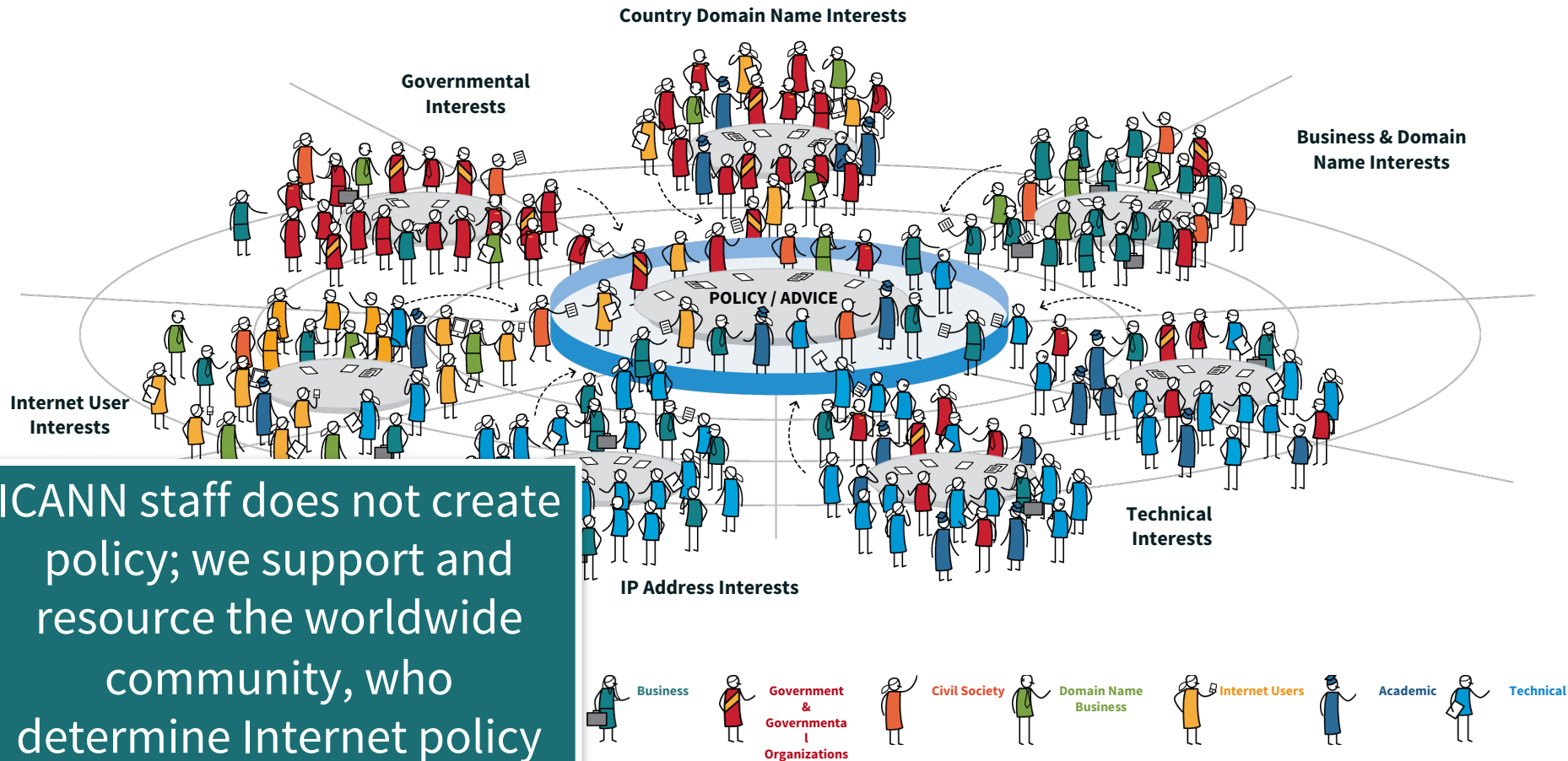

The collective efforts of the ICANN community culminate in a common shared goal:

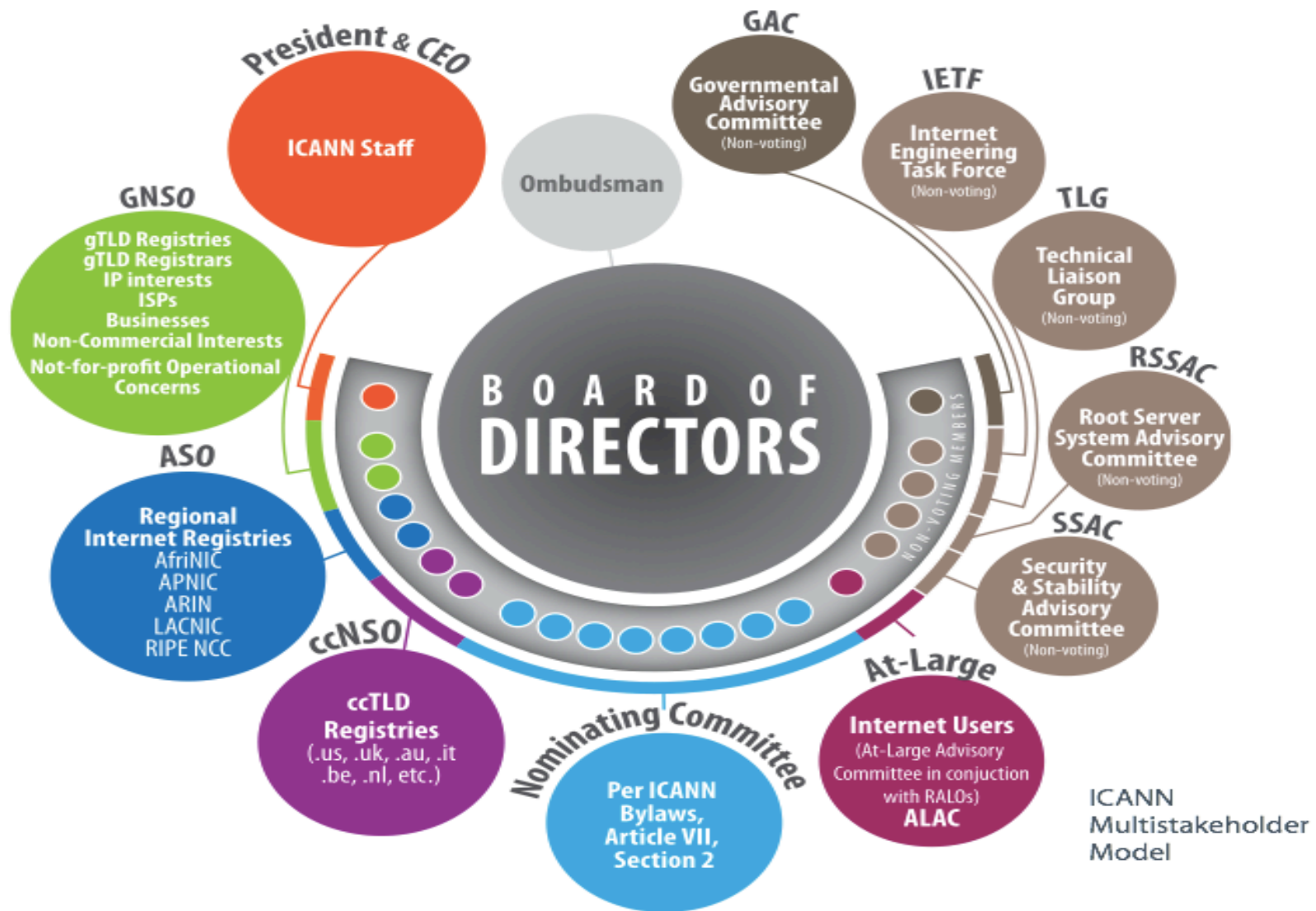
A single, interoperable Internet supported by stable, secure and resilient unique identifier systems

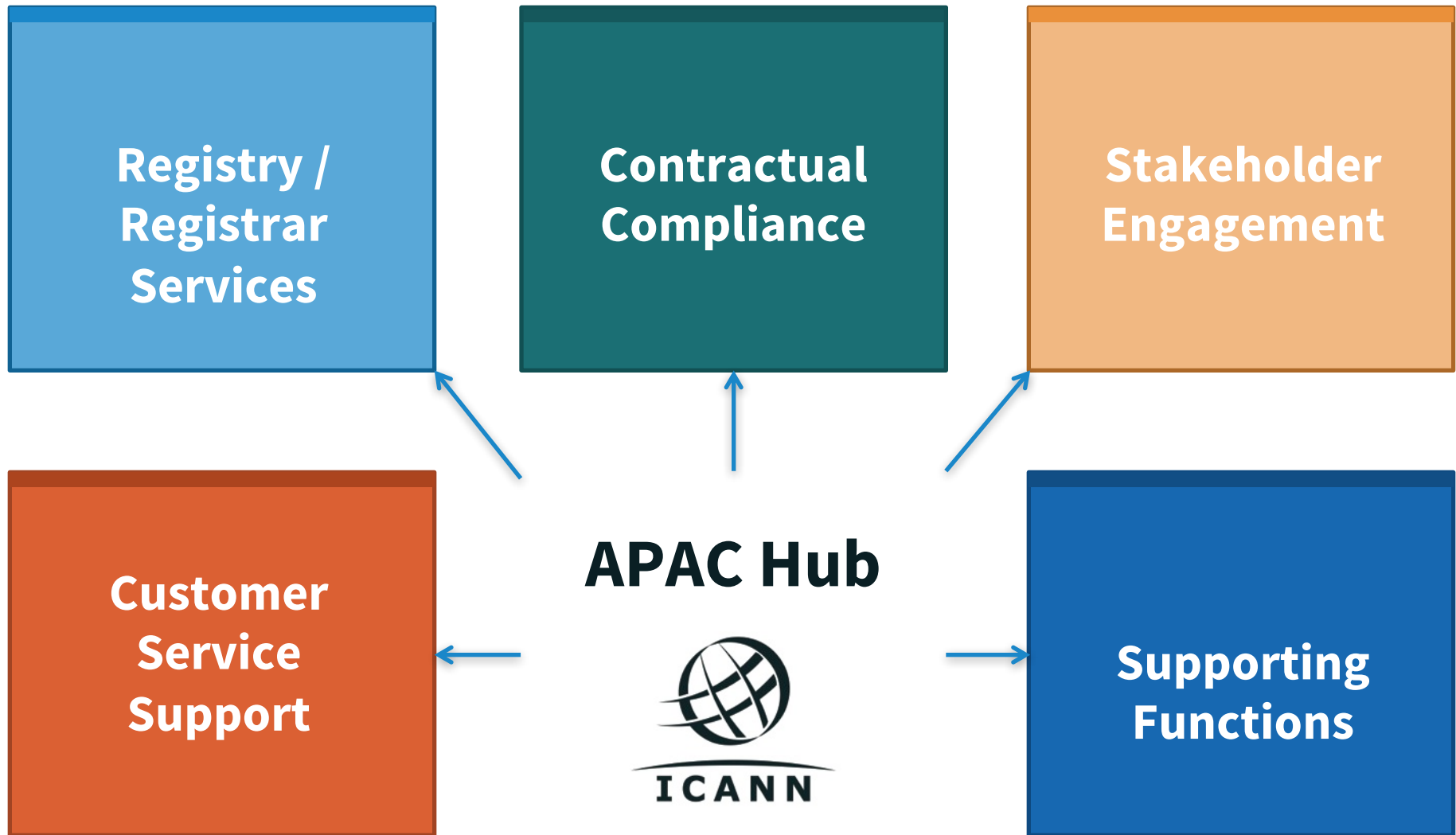

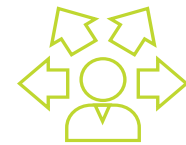

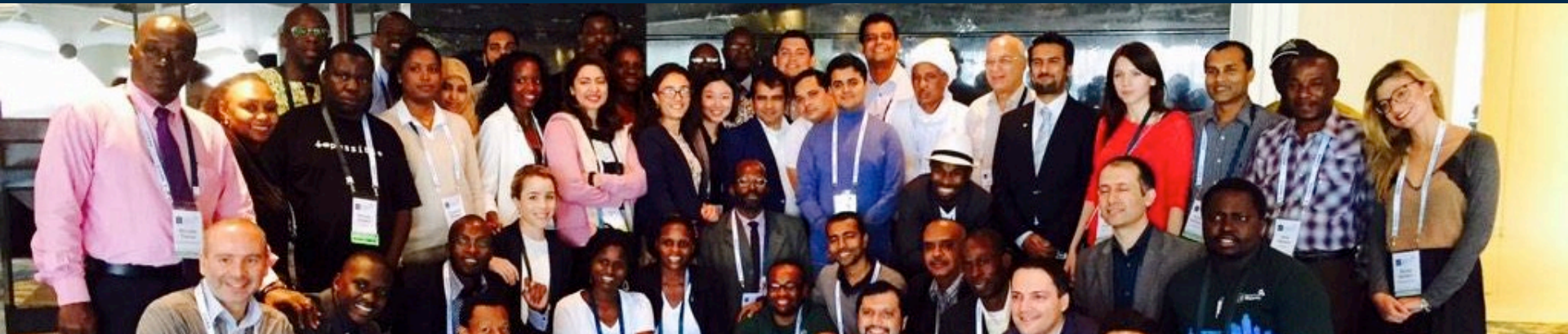
