Engagement in general ICT policy making process

- consultation with experts and stakeholders
- public hearing
- public input period after pre-announcement of legislation
- lobbying to the national assembly

Limitation of engagement

- Participation in a consultation is often selective
- Process is not open and transparent.
- Public hearing / public input : lack of discussion or feedback
