I would like to volunteer for the AoC Review Team on Security, Stability and Resilience of the DNS.

I want to bring my breadth of experiences, and the perspective of a global internet company with billions of daily active users, to bear in helping to conduct a successful SSR review. Supporting ICANN's ability to enhance the operational stability, reliability, resiliency, security, and global interoperability of the DNS, and keep pace with evolving threats to the DNS, is a top priority for Facebook in its engagement with ICANN.
