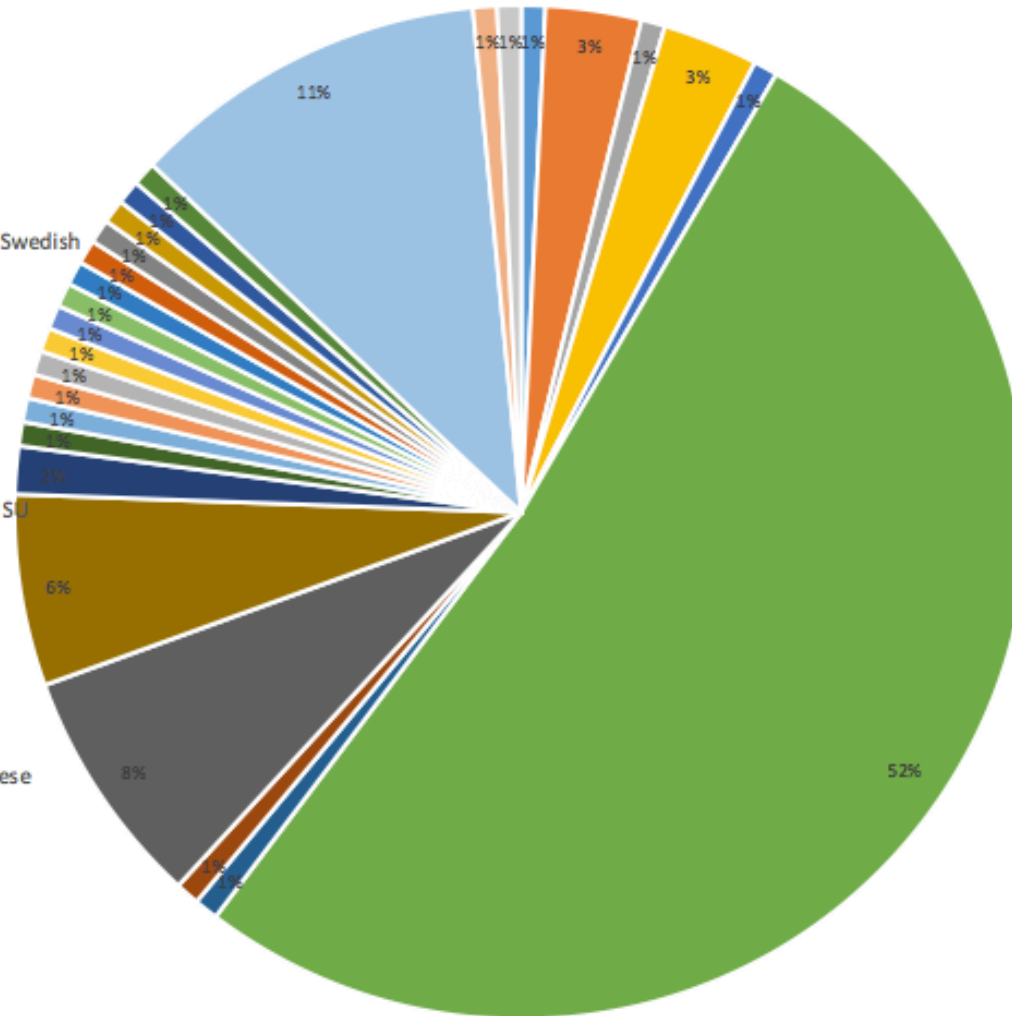

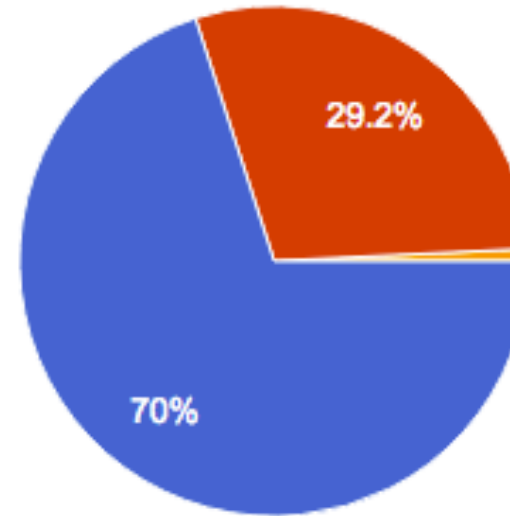

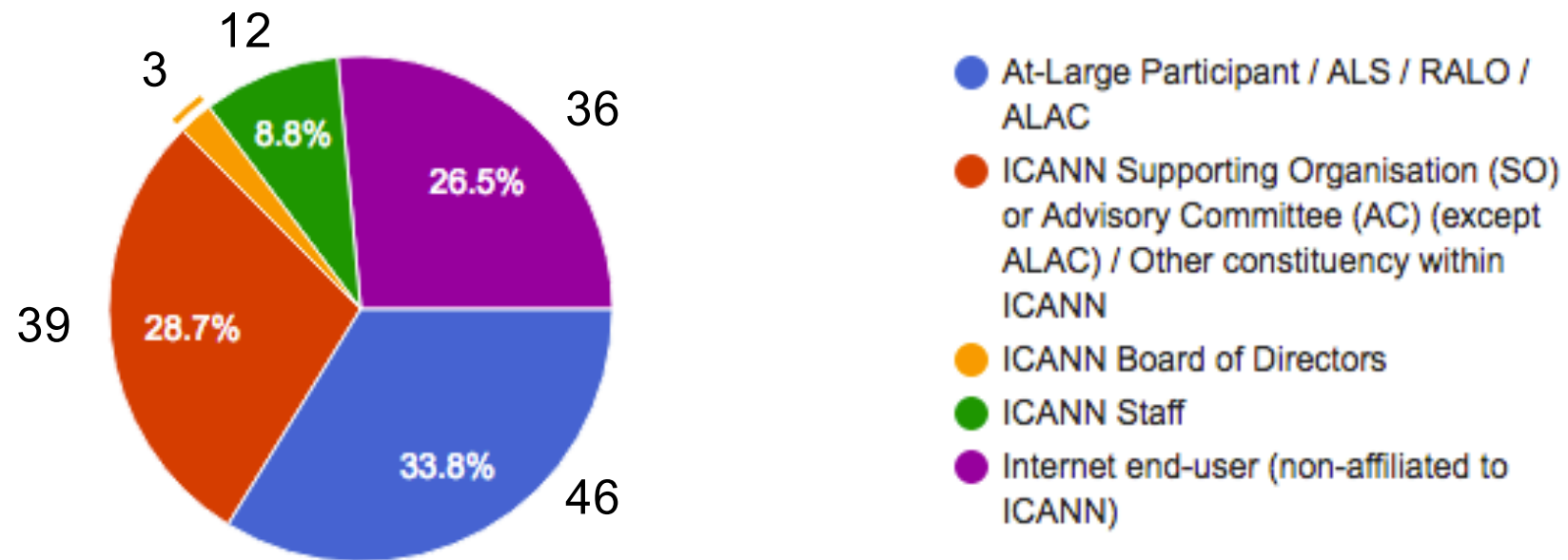

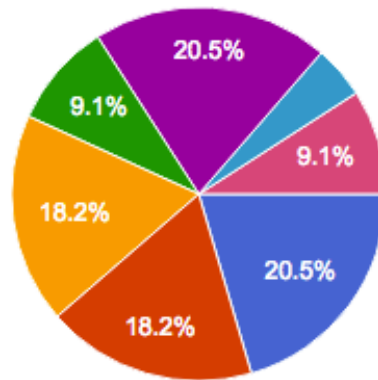

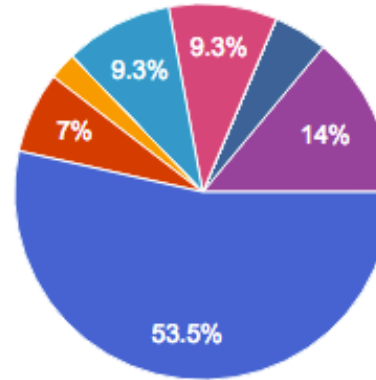
ALS typology

Yrs of At-Large membership



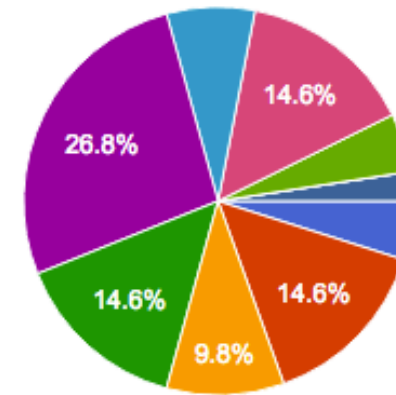

- Need to maintain institutional capacities vs need to renew leadership / identify next generation of leaders.
- Capacity of RALOs to engage with End-Users.
- Stark differences of opinion on RALOs efforts to engage with end-users in each region and the appropriateness of the system of RALOs to ensure End User representation within ICANN.
- Need for better integration / more synergies to be found between outreach efforts by ICANN Organisation and ICANN Community.
- Effective use of translation and interpretation services is questioned.
