Defining the Working Scope and Structure of WG

WG Working Scope (tentative):

- Defining the working task list;
- Identify and discuss possible solutions for issues in the work list;
- Reach agreement on solution for the issues or reach conclusion for a subject;
- Draft WG reports according to the discussion.

• WG Structure:

- should there be a registrar chair-person for the WG or someone who could be the lead registrar representative, if not a formal "chair"?)
- Or utilize ICANN staff as the lead person.



Proposed tasks list of the WG

- 1. Work on the issue of which countries' addresses should be verified to what level (100% accuracy for all area, or less than 100% accuracy is acceptable, and why?)
- 2. Work on the issue of data format (ASCII, Non-ASCII/conversion, data field sequence)
- 3. Work on the issue of pre-registration validation (real-time) vs. post-registration validation
- 4. Work on the issue of data transmission portal/method, service provider system response time, etc.
- 5. Work on the issue of validation result feedback/response (success/error/failure/warning)
- 6. Work on the issue of error/failure/warning handling
- 7. Work on the issue of report format (success/error/failure)
- 8. Work on the issue of service agreement arrangement with provider(s)
- 9. Work on the issue of implementation approach and potential alternative cost structures
- 10. Work on the issue of compliance and monitoring mechanisms
