Statistics

In the last two years, ICANN has averaged ~4 proceedings/month.

The average length for a proceeding was 43 calendar days in 2010-2011, but has averaged **51 days** from 2012-2016.

During the seven-year period from 2010-2016, a proceeding receives a relatively stable median of **5-7 comments**.

During the past two years (2015-2016), **91% of all proceedings** have been open for at least 40 days.

Process Management

The Policy Development Support team now manages the public comment process, ensuring timeliness and adherance to guidelines.



Minimum 40-day Proceedings

Any proceeding between 21 and 39 days requires approval from two ICANN Executives.

A report summarizing and analyzing the comments is due two weeks after the close date (unless other timeframe is established).

Brief Overview


