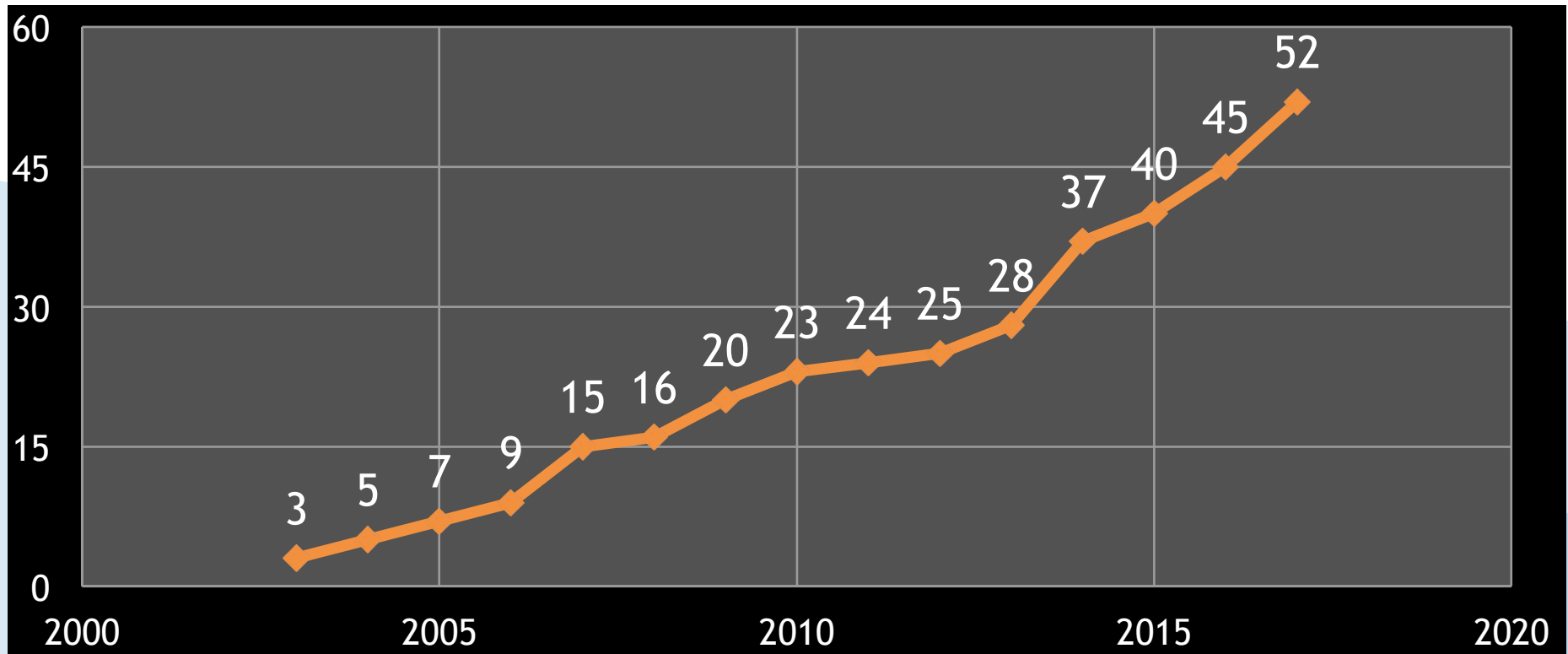


AFRALO: *"The Voice of Internet users in Africa"*

10 selected by RALOs to serve on the ALAC (2 from each RALO)

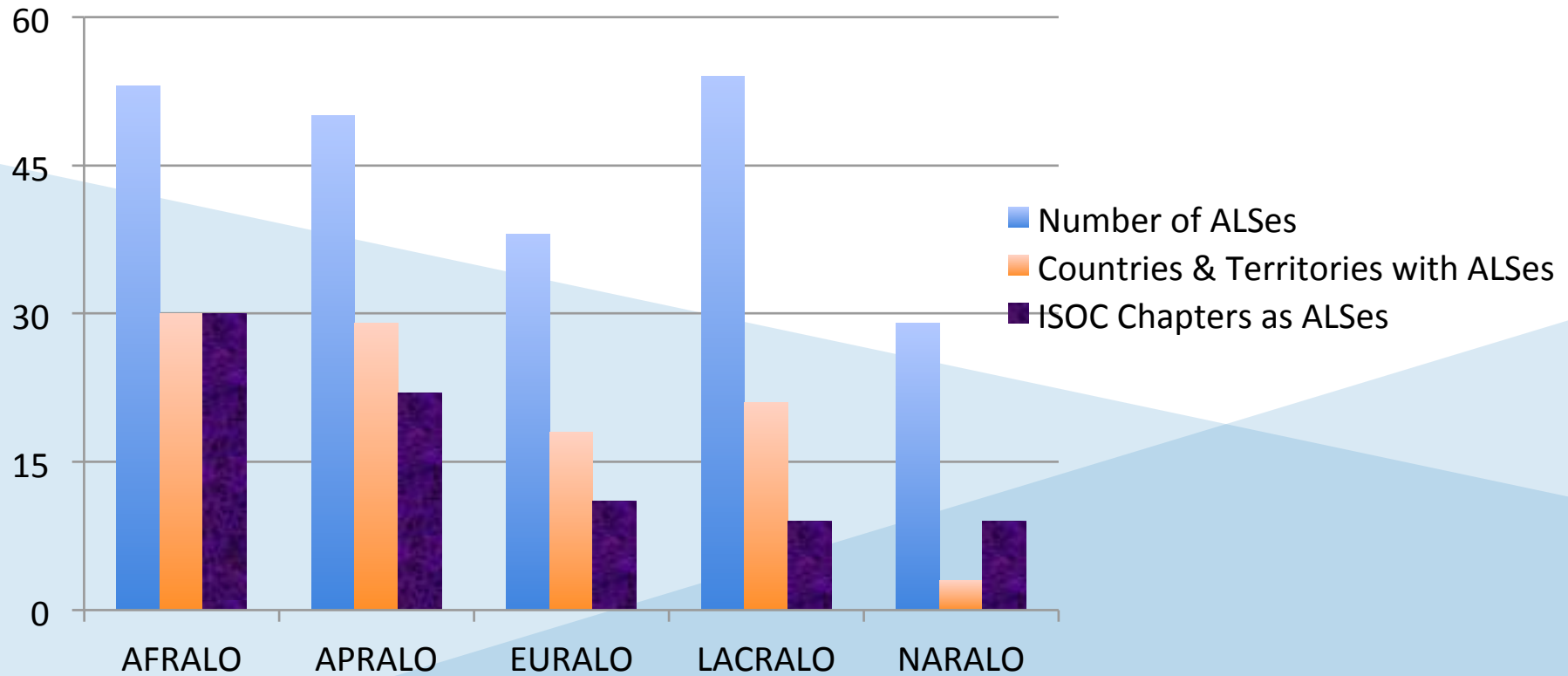


5 selected by Nom Com to serve on the ALAC (1 from each region)

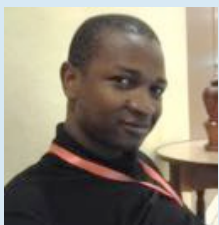
