

CSC Findings of IANA Naming Function Performance Report for the Month of May 2021

Date: 16 June 2021

Overall Finding

The CSC completed review of the May 2021 IANA Naming Function Performance Report and finds that PTI's performance for the month was:

Satisfactory- PTI's performance over May 2021 was 98.4%. PTI met 63 of the 64 currently defined thresholds. The missed service level agreement was satisfactorily explained and not an indication of a systemic issue with PTI's performance:
