WHAT THIS PROJECT IS ABOUT

In April 2015, the ICANN Board reaffirmed 'its request for a Board-initiated GNSO policy development process to define the purpose of collecting, maintaining and providing access to generic top-level domain (gTLD) registration data, and consider safeguards for protecting data, using the recommendations in the Expert Working Group (EWG) Final Report as an input to, and, if appropriate, as the foundation for a new gTLD policy'.

Following publication of the PDP Final Issue Report, the GNSO Council adopted the charter for the PDP WG, which commenced its deliberations at the end of January 2016. During the **first phase its work**, the WG has been tasked with providing the GNSO Council with recommendations on the following two questions:

- 1) What are the fundamental requirements for gTLD registration data?
- 2) Is a new policy framework and next-generation registration directory services (RDS) needed to address these requirements?



What are the current issues under discussion?

- Issues now under discussion: Phase 1 deliberation on Fundamental Requirements for 4 charter questions, focusing initially on a "Minimum Public Data Set"
 - Users/Purposes: Who should have access to gTLD registration data in the "Minimum Public Data Set" and why (for what purposes)?
 - Gated Access: What steps should be taken to control data access to the "Minimum Public Data Set"?
 - Data Elements: What data in the "Minimum Public Data Set" should be collected, stored, and disclosed?
 - o Privacy: For the "Minimum Public Data Set" only, what steps are needed to protect data and privacy?
- 26 initial points of rough consensus reached to date are reflected in our working document
- ICANN59 Cross-Community Session on RDS will be used to solicit community questions and feedback



What are the current challenges?

- Current challenges include burnout, complexity, duration, and conflicting views
 - When agreeing upon individual requirements proved difficult, we refocused on "Key Concepts"
 - To find common ground, we narrowed the focus of <u>initial</u> <u>deliberation</u> to "thin data" -- leading to definition of a "Minimum Public Data Set" to be accessible for all gTLDs, without authentication
 - Having nearly concluded our pass on this data, we will now expand our focus to other data elements
- Given importance of answers to WG questions on privacy and data protection, independent legal analysis is being pursued




What are the current challenges? (continued)

- WG membership has grown significantly since ICANN58 currently 192 members, 171 observers
 - Presents both opportunity and challenges
- WG members have deeply held positions
 - Difficulty focusing on topic at hand, often revisiting points previously covered
- WG email has at times become offensive to some, tense and unconstructive, too voluminous to follow
 - WG leadership is working with Ombudsman to help address concerns raised
