What is Engagement at ICANN?

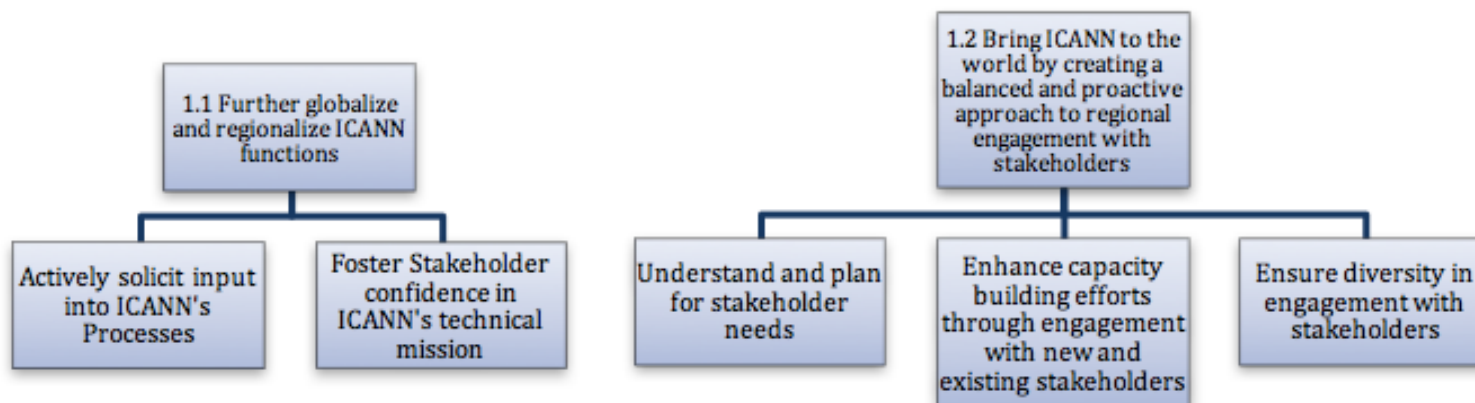
- Global Stakeholder Engagement is a community-facing team, supporting ICANN's Mission in our regions.
- Process by which ICANN involves people who may be affected by ICANN's work or can influence the implementation of its decisions.

What is Engagement at ICANN?

- Informing stakeholders, raising awareness in ICANN, initiating their engagement in ICANN's work
- Representing ICANN with various groups, bring in new participants in ICANN and maintaining relationships with existing stakeholders
- Supporting stakeholders to become active participants and leaders in ICANN's activities, and supporting the work of other functions of ICANN Org with the community

Our engagement approach

- Under the new ICANN Bylaws, as ICANN must ensure its decisions and actions include “**broad, informed participation reflecting the functional, geographic, and cultural diversity of the Internet at all levels of policy development and decision-making.**”



Outcomes from engagement

- Attract more active and engaged participants to contribute to ICANN's policy development processes and technical mission

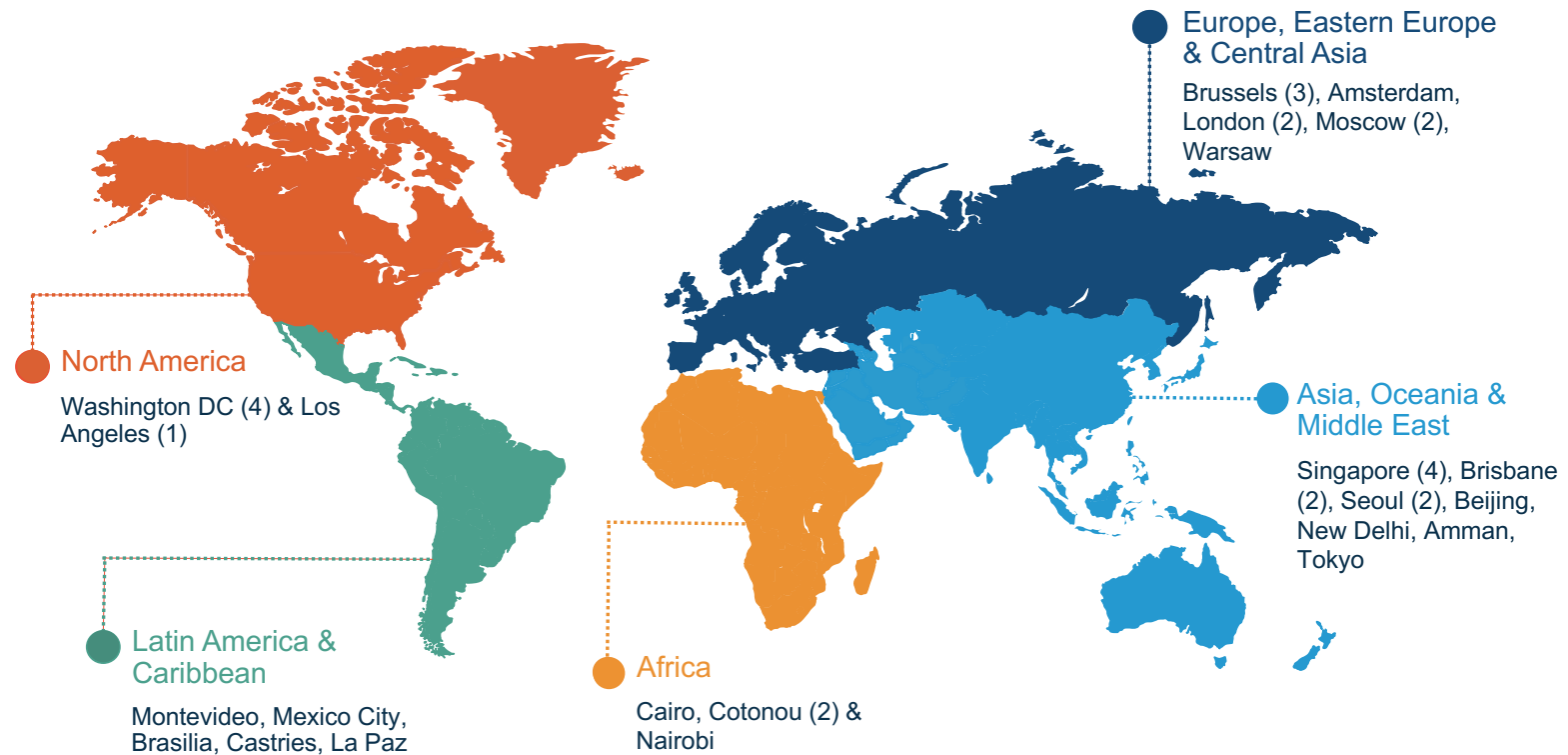
