Recommendations - 2

- Open ICANN Board Meeting: Request one Held in Africa in 1999. Latin America has Requested January 1999.
- Address SO: AfriNIC should inform other Registries and Apply to be part of SO

Recommendations - 3

- Domain Name SO: Get AFTLD active and participate (complex group: + users, Trademarks, NSI etc.)
- Protocol SO: Participate in IETF (even more complex)
- Form ISOC Chapters (Language and Cultural mechanism)
- Participate, DON'T Disrupt - Its voluntary
- BUILD African Internetworks!
