Alex Deacon:sounds like a reasonable suggestion to me.

Eric Rokobauer:+1 Greg

Roger Carney:Agree

Darcy Southwell:Agree with Greg.

Vicky Sheckler:agree w/ metaltiz

Lord Buckethead:I still have an issue with them trying to dictate our work timelines

Greg DiBiase:it was me. I think its pretty self explanatory

Greg DiBiase:no further comments

steve metalitz:Do not see this suggestion in document circulated before the call.....

Darcy Southwell:I'm not sure that a "policy authority" has the ability to decide ... it does not in the U.S.

steve metalitz:OK to ad "police authority"

steve metalitz:it will vary by country

Darcy Southwell:Or change the "i.e." to "e.g."

Vicky Sheckler:+1 steve

Roger Carney:I like that Darcy

Volker Greimann:what does that actually mean

Volker Greimann:yes, but what does "police authority" actually mean?

steve metalitz:@Volker, Lord Buckethead might know

Nick Shorey:Hi everyone - apologies I'm late

Volker Greimann:hehe

Volker Greimann:what is in that definition and what is not?

Volker Greimann:does secret service have PA, does the military?

Volker Greimann:does private eye gumshoe?  
Eric Rokobauer:+1 Roger  
steve metalitz:wouldn't that fit under 2.1.2?  
Greg DiBiase:2..1.2 works too. Probably better actually  
Eric Rokobauer:That works  
Eric Rokobauer:We need priority defined  
Vicky Sheckler:apologies - need to leaave the call early  
Darcy Southwell:+1 Roger  
Greg DiBiase:agreee with roger  
steve metalitz:That appears in 4/1/2 and could be moved here  
Darcy Southwell:Rationale is especially important since I'm not certain that the Requestor always has authority to set this timeframe.  
Roger Carney:Agree with Steve  
Volker Greimann:I oppose publication the LEA contact on our website  
Volker Greimann:this just means that everyone will use that contact as they believe it will cause faster action  
Volker Greimann:same as in the RAA  
Alex Deacon:sounds ok to me.  
Volker Greimann:exactly. if it is good enough for registrars, it is good enough for PP  
Darcy Southwell:I believe the intent of the PDP was to mirror the RAA.  
Nick Shorey:In terms of process - the contact point needs to be immediately accessible  
Roger Carney:@ Amy, I think that is a good proposal  
steve metalitz:24 hours is to acknowledge receipt and completeness, not to act on request  
Volker Greimann:still 24 is too short  
Darcy Southwell:I believe there was a comment on the email list about the challenge to this 24-hour period.  
Volker Greimann:pp providers are staffed even worse than registrars.  
Sarah Wyld:Agreed that 24 hours is not adequate time  
Volker Greimann:we have week-ends, holidays, etc  
Darcy Southwell:+1 Volker  
Sarah Wyld:Even 48 hours may not be enough, on a long weekend  
Alex Deacon:so what should it be?  
Darcy Southwell:1-2 business days  
Darcy Southwell:Just throwing that out there.  
Sarah Wyld:Yes, I think business days makes more sense  
Sarah Wyld:2 business days if not 3.  
Darcy Southwell:Business days at the location of the P/P provider.  
Eric Rokobauer:Agree with Darcy referencing business day terms

Greg DiBiase:2 business days works for me  
Darcy Southwell:Agree  
steve metalitz:This will have to be neogtiated with LE  
Sarah Wyld:Agreed.  
Sara Bockey:I need to drop for another meeting. Thanks all.  
Greg DiBiase:Have to drop, thanks all  
steve metalitz:"Actioned in accordance with 4.2 and 4.3"?
