ICANN & the Public Interest

Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of OCT 2016:

"{...} **promoting the global public interest** in the operational stability of the Internet **by carrying out the mission** set forth in the bylaws of the Corporation {...}"

"Such global public interest may be **determined from time to time**."

"Any determination of such global public interest shall be made by the multistakeholder community through an inclusive bottom-up multistakeholder community process."



ICANN & the Public Interest

The public interest is also present in the Strategic Plan:

Vision

 ICANN builds trust through serving the public interest, and incorporating the <u>transparent and effective cooperation among stakeholders</u> worldwide to facilitate its coordination role.

<u>Objective</u>

- Evolve and further globalize ICANN
- Support a healthy, stable, and resilient unique identifier ecosystem
- Advance organizational, technological and operational excellence
- Promote ICANN's role and multistakeholder approach
- Develop and implement a global public interest framework bounded by ICANN's mission.

2014: IANA Functions Stewardship Transition Announcement

Public Interest Discussions

- Definition of the global public interest proposed by the Panel on Public Responsibility Framework (as it relates to the Internet):
 - "ensuring that the Internet becomes, and continues to be, stable, inclusive, and accessible across the globe so that all may enjoy the benefits of a single and open Internet. In addressing its public responsibility, ICANN must build trust in the Internet and its governance ecosystem."



Public Interest Discussions

Definition vs. no definition

- Provides structure
- Highly context-driven

How is it understood & applied in different contexts

• Explored Europe and India

Everything ICANN does is rooted in the public interest

- Develop best practices in multistakeholder systems
- Enhance diversity in stakeholder participation

SSR of the DNS (or diversity) is but one element of the public interest

- The aggregate of **all** special interests = the public interest
- PI is an abstract concept, it needs adaptable process, not a fixed definition

The public interest is designed to be self-executing in the new Bylaws

• If the bottom-up, multistakeholder process is followed, and the end result is supported by consensus, then the global public interest is automatically served.
