Status of Subteam's Work

- First meeting held 16 June
 - Discussed logistics, high-level issues
- Next task: identify proposed solutions
 - Data escrow
 - De-accreditation
 - Other issues?



Over-Arching Considerations

- Final Report contemplated that third-party providers would exist
- Goal of this accreditation program is to get providers to become accredited and comply with accreditation requirements
- We should not create undue roadblocks to accreditation (or providers may not seek accreditation)
- We should not unfairly restrict any category of providers



Topic 1: Data Escrow Issues

• Issues raised:

- O What happens if an unaffiliated provider is deaccredited and its data escrow deposits are bad or nonexistent?
- What are the impacts on data escrow if the provider registers names through >1 registrar?
- O Do these issues differ based on TPP's business model?
 - Reseller;
 - Affiliated with one Registrar, provides services through other registrars;
 - Completely free-standing provider.
- Any other issues that should be considered?



Topic 1: Potential Data Escrow Solutions

- Proposed solutions raised to date:
 - Could unaffiliated providers be required to escrow additional data?
 - Should there be additional or more frequent audits of third party providers' data escrow deposits?
 - Should providers be required to track which registrars their customers' names are registered through, in the event the customer transfers to another registrar without the provider's knowledge?
- Updated escrow specifications (in RA) have added requirements re: formatting, reporting
- Other potential solutions?

- Subteam requested to continue discussing potential solutions on-list, with goal of finalizing list of proposed solution(s) for data escrow-related challenges by 14 July
- Next step—discuss de-accreditation challenges and potential solutions; can begin discussion on-list prior to next meeting
- Next meeting—21 July
- Goal—complete subteam work by 28 July so that proposed solutions can be discussed with full IRT 1 August



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
