# ATLAS III – What, Where and When



ATLAS III is planned to take place at ICANN 64 9-14 March 2019 in Kobe, Japan subject to funding.

ATLAS III will build upon the successful activities of the At-Large community since the second ATLAS, which was held alongside the ICANN Meeting in London in June 2014.

The first ATLAS was held alongside the ICANN Meeting in Mexico in March 2009 – an event of fundamental importance since it became the foundation stone to the involvement of many of our At-Large Structures (ALSes) in ICANN.
