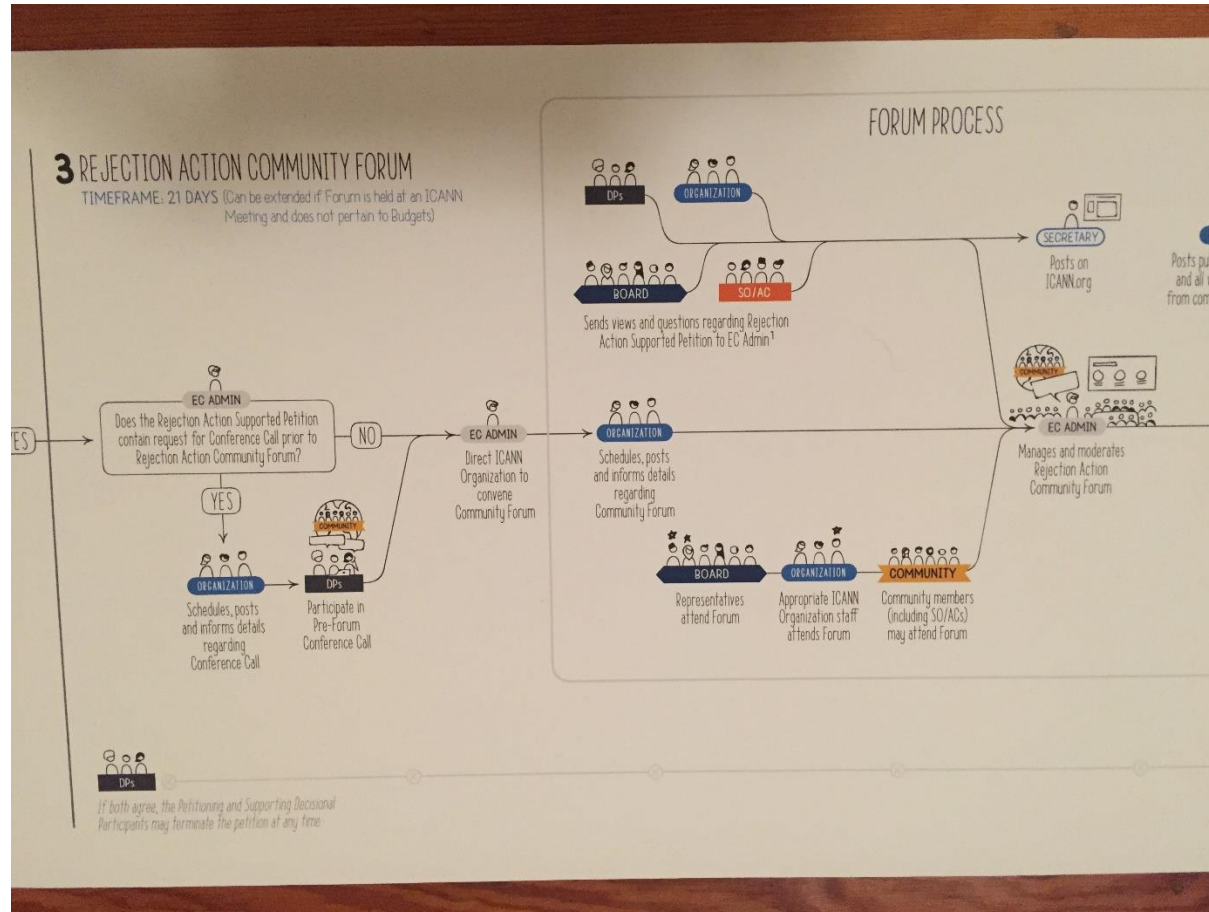
Remaining Steps...

 - b. ICANN Provided flowchart of the Rejection Action Process (i.e., the flowchart that was displayed by ICANN at ICANN-59)
4. Publish to the GRC-WG for the WG's review/comments
