

Reviews: main areas of engagement

- GNSO Review (2014) Implementation
 - "Chartering" all recommendations
 - Determine process, time, budget, staff
 - Report to OEC and GNSO Council
- GNSO Review (2019)
 - Prepare for a structural review
 - Consider NCPH related processes
- SSR2 Review
 - Support to continue the work started
 - Ensure that this and similar reviews remain fully under the community control
