Stephanie Perrin: There are a number of policies that will have to be tweaked when ICANN comes into compliance with Data Protection law. I would say the topic is much wider than GDPR.

Renata Aquino Ribeiro:can't we do like a Q & A q/Legal as to discuss several topics?

Paul McGrady:Old

Vicky Sheckler:agree w/ delbianco

Stephanie Perrin: I would certainly like to ask halloran how he is coming along with a privacy policy.....

Barbara Wanner:agree with Steve on shorter session

Stephanie Perrin:I think it is extremely important to have more control of the terms of reference for the consultants. Also would like insight into the selection process for those consultants.

Renata Aquino Ribeiro: yes i'll send info for dial out

Renata Aquino Ribeiro:sorry

Steve DelBianco [BC]:Akram

Ayden Férdeline: I think 90 minutes for slot F is a good length. fully agree with Stephanie that we should invite Halloran to answer questions re: privacy policy

Steve DelBianco [BC]: Seems if we ask questions over and over, Akram eventually gives us an answer!

Tatiana Tropina: Yes, the CSG+NCSG partnership in moderation was a very good idea Tatiana Tropina: (or co-chairing)

Steve DelBianco [BC]:we go our own way for dinner on Day 1, right

Raoul Plommer (NPOC):Let's try to have a list of likely subjects where CSG and NCSG find common ground and discuss those, in some kind of a doodle voting or something.

Renata Aquino Ribeiro:+1 partnership

Stephanie Perrin:Not to be fixated on the legal issues, but I have a number of questions on how the new Directive on policing and data protection (which the EDPS will be responsible for enforcing) intersects with GDPR. Is anyone on the commercial side interested in this topic?

Farzaneh Badii:yes equal time if we consolidate

Steve DelBianco [BC]:prepared questions should be collated by the session co-chairs, and presented in their slides, Renata

Farzaneh Badii:ok we will discuss that internally Steve and get back to NCPH

Renata Aquino Ribeiro: yes, Steve but also some can be advanced - there are issues which are continuously in focus so speakers should be prepared to address them

Renata Aquino Ribeiro:old hadn

Stephanie Perrin: I see no uptake on the topic of the Directive on policing....but it is going to impact the private sector security businesses, who will be under the GDPR and subject to fines if they don't comply with the Directive, according to my understanding of the matter. It is therefore rather important to ICANN and I have seen no discussion of the matter.
