




APPLICATION STAGES



GAC'S ADVISE

- Address applications that are identified by governments to be problematic e.g., that potentially violate national law or raise sensitivities.
- The GAC can provide advice on any application for the consideration of the ICANN Board during the evaluation process.





OBJECTION GROUNDS



String is confusingly similar to an existing TLD or to another applied-for gTLD string - delegating two or more similar TLDs could cause user confusion

info vs.infos

Legal Rights

String violates the legal rights of the objector

-> .coach

Limited Public Interest

String contradicts generally accepted legal norms of morality and public order recognized under principles of international law


Community

Substantial opposition to the gTLD application exists from a significant portion of the community that the gTLD string targets

→ .bank (affiliated with banking association /owner of various domain name registrars

APPLICANTS'S OPTIONS IN THE EVENT OF OBJECTION

- (1) Work to reach the settlement with the objector, resulting in withdrawal of the objection or the application
- (2) File a response to the objection and enter the dispute resolution process
- (3) Withdraw, in which case the objector will prevail by default and the application will not proceed further





DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS












Criterion #1: Community Establishment (0-4 points)

A maximum of 4 points is possible on the Nexus criterion:




