Challenges to IG in South Korea

- *Act on Internet Address Resources* : conflicting condition
 - Government regulation vs. Multi-stakeholder governance
 - Funnel effect in discussion : barrier to emerging issues and capacity building
- Weak participation
 - Government
 - Private sector
 - Others
- Lack of strategy for sustainability
 - recruiting next generation
 - developing capacity building program
 - participation in global fora strategically

The Needs

- Practitioners'
 - to participate in global/regional/local Internet governance through understanding the definition, perspectives, actors, institutions/fora, and issues.
- Next generation's
 - to empower next generation to be next leaders through enhancing the literacy and experience on Internet governance
 - Focus on graduate school students of International Relations, global governance,
