# **RDS PDP: Project Timeline & Major Milestones**



#### WHAT THIS PROJECT IS ABOUT

In April 2015, the ICANN Board reaffirmed "its request for a Board-initiated GNSO policy development process to define the purpose of collecting, maintaining and providing access to generic top-level domain (gTLD) registration data, and consider s

providing access to generic top-level domain (gTLD) registration data, and consider safeguards for protecting data, using the recommendations in the Expert Working Group (EWG) Final Report as an input to, and, if appropriate, as the foundation for a new gTLD policy."

Following publication of the PDP Final Issue Report, the GNSO Council adopted the charter for the PDP WG, which commenced its deliberations at the end of January 2016. During the **first phase its work**, the WG has been tasked with providing recommendations on the following two questions:

- 1) What are the fundamental requirements for gTLD registration data?
- 2) Is a new policy framework and next-generation registration directory services (RDS) needed to address these requirements?

# Why focus on purpose now?

- Throughout deliberation, we have repeatedly run into questions that depend upon purpose
- Past efforts also ran into the same challenge for example, see
   <u>SAC055</u>, <u>WHOIS</u>: <u>Blind Men and an Elephant</u> (September 2012)
- This is why the ICANN Board tasked this WG with answering the question of purpose:
  - Resolved (2015.04.26.10), the Board reaffirms its request for a Boardinitiated GNSO policy development process to define the purpose of collecting, maintaining and providing access to gTLD registration data, and consider safeguards for protecting data
- Clearly defining purposes is a pre-requisite for reaching consensus agreements regarding which purposes are to be considered legitimate



# We'll start with purposes previously discussed

Question: For what specific (legitimate) purposes should gTLD registration data elements in the "Minimum Public Data Set" be collected?

- 5. Domain name control is a legitimate purpose for "Minimum Public Data Set" collection.
- 6. Technical Issue Resolution is a legitimate purpose for "Minimum Public Data Set" collection.
- 7. Domain Name Certification is a legitimate purpose for "Minimum Public Data Set" collection.
- 8. Business Domain Name Purchase or Sale is a legitimate purpose for "Minimum Public Data Set" collection.
- 9. Academic / Public Interest DNS Research is a legitimate purpose for "Minimum Public Data Set" collection.
- 10. Regulatory and Contractual Enforcement is a legitimate purpose for "Minimum Public Data Set" collection.
- 11. Criminal Investigation & DNS Abuse Mitigation is a legitimate purpose for "Minimum Public Data Set" collection.
- 12. Legal Actions is a legitimate purpose for "Minimum Public Data Set" collection.
- 13. Individual Internet Use is a legitimate purpose for "Minimum Public Data Set" collection

# **Examples of single-sentence purposes**

 Let's all try to summarize each purpose in a single sentence:
 "Information collected to enable contact between the registrant and <who> <to accomplish what>"

Information collected to enable contact between the registrant and/or their designated point of contact and third parties wishing to resolve technical issues associated with the domain name

Information collected to enable contact between the registrant and/or their designated point of contact and third parties as required to ensure the domain name registration remains under the control of authorized user and to ensure no unauthorized changes are made

Information collected to enable contact between the registrant organization and/or their designated point of contact and individual Internet users to promote consumer confidence when accessing sites that use the domain name



# **Next Steps and Action Items**

- Continue Drafting Teams through next week to address these points:
  - Summarize each purpose in one sentence:
     "Information collected to enable contact between the registrant and <who> <to accomplish what>"
  - b. Think in terms of explaining to the data subject why data is being collected for this purpose keep it concise and simple.
  - c. Are the tasks/users identified by your team so diverse and distinct that they may be more than one purpose? If so, split them up and describe each purpose separately.
  - d. Which purposes covered by other teams are closely related to or overlap the purpose(s) covered by your team?
  - e. Is there any data collected specifically for the stated purpose? Or does that purpose use only data collected for other purposes?
- Action: Drafting teams to <u>deliver final outputs</u> by Friday 10 November
- Action: Drafting teams to present results to full WG on 14 Nov call

### **MPDS**

Initial WG deliberation focused on "thin data" as defined by the Thick WHOIS Report:

"A thin registry only stores and manages the information associated with the domain name. This set includes data sufficient to identify the sponsoring registrar, status of the registration, creation and expiration dates for each registration, name server data, the last time the record was updated in its Whois data store, and the URL for the registrar's Whois service."

### **Example:**

Domain Name: EXAMPLE.TLD WHOIS Server: whois.example.tld Referral URL: http://www.example.tld Updated Date: 2009-05-29T20:13:00Z Creation Date: 2000-10-08T00:45:00Z

Registry Expiry Date: 2010-10-08T00:44:59Z

Sponsoring Registrar: EXAMPLE REGISTRAR LLC

Sponsoring Registrar IANA ID: 5555555 Domain Status: clientDeleteProhibited

Name Server: NS01.EXAMPLEREGISTRAR.TLD Name Server: NS02.EXAMPLEREGISTRAR.TLD

**DNSSEC:** signedDelegation

WG agreements refer to these as the "Minimum Public Data Set" (MPDS)
