# **Background**

- Proposed Privacy/Proxy accreditation process is modeled on registrar accreditation process
- IRT advised that process should be streamlined wherever possible for affiliates
- Updates to Applicant Guide from v1:
  - Streamlined process for affiliates
  - Fees proposal added
- IRT feedback is requested on all elements of this document



### IRT Feedback to Date on Draft v2

- Initial application window process may be too complicated/cumbersome
- More details needed to evaluate accreditation criteria
- Document markups sent to list included recommendations to:
  - Revert to definitions of "privacy" and "proxy" used in Final Report
  - Reduce fees
  - Replace essay-type policy/contract questions with "confirm that applicant will comply"/check the boxtype questions



# **Proposed Changes to Process (Initial Window)**

- Eliminate "expression of interest" step and allow onestep application submission
- Consult materials already available for affiliated providers
  - This is already taken into account during evaluation stage—see streamlined application for affiliates
- Make requirement that registrars not knowingly accept registrations from unaccredited providers effective 3 months after completion of initial application phase
- Other IRT suggestions?



### IRT Feedback to Date on Accreditation Criteria

### Proposed criteria:

- Clear compliance check for any affiliated contracted parties;
  - What does this mean?
- Have at least one current employee who has completed educational program;
- Clear all due diligence checks;
  - Reduce list of background check criteria and time period reviewed
- Demonstrate understanding of policy and contractual requirements;
  - This isn't needed for affiliates
- Demonstrate access to adequate capital;
  - What is "adequate"?



### IRT Feedback to Date on Accreditation Criteria

### Proposed criteria:

- Demonstrate adequate technical infrastructure;
  - What is "adequate"? Is this needed at all?
     Datacenter/Tier III requirement should be eliminated
- Demonstrate adequate planning for occurrence of security breaches, natural disasters, infrastructure and/or business failure
  - What does this mean?
- Any additional IRT feedback today?
- ICANN will provide more detail on criteria shortly for additional discussion



## IRT Feedback on Affiliate Categories

### Types of affiliate relationship:

- No affiliation with any contracted party
- Applicant affiliated with gTLD registry operator only
- Applicant affiliated with ICANN-accredited registrar
- Applicant affiliated with ICANN-accredited PP Provider (only during program maintenance phase)
- No IRT feedback on categories themselves to date. Any additional feedback on categories?
- IRT feedback on criteria by category:
  - Some IRT members said too much is being asked of affiliates;
  - Other IRT members said application cut too much for affiliates.



## **Summary: Application for Non-Affiliate**

- Draft application for non-affiliates includes:
  - General information (name, address, primary contact information;
  - Background screening questions;
  - Completion of educational program;
  - Questions about data escrow processes, transition planning in event of de-accreditation;
  - Operational, policy and contractual questions;
  - Documentation of corporate status/good standing;
  - Financial statement; and
  - Datacenter certification documentation.



# **Summary: Application for Registrar Affiliates**

- Draft application for registrar affiliates includes:
  - General information (name, address, primary contact information;
  - Background screening questions;
  - Completion of educational program;
  - Questions about data escrow processes, transition planning in event of de-accreditation;
  - Documentation of corporate status/good standing;



# **Proposed Program Fee Structure**

- Application Fees:
  - \$3,500 for non-affiliates
  - \$2,000 for affiliates

No transaction-based or variable fees
