Lisa Phifer: (13:35) a formal meeting would include travel support and allow for decisions to be made. Informal meeting does incur costs (eg catering) but not nearly as much .

Susan Kawaguchi: (13:42) welcome and glad they are sleeping!

Lisa Phifer: (13:45) may consider weekly calls until ToR and Workplan are adopted and subteams are formed and briefings are completed. At that point, subgroups might better spend weekly time together?
