Volker Greimann - RrSG:We should also note that "purpose" in the meaning of our group does not necessarily match the definition of "purpose" under data protection laws. So there may be a purpose that is legitimate, but that does not meet the legal requirements for collection and/or provision

Rod Rasmussen:Maxim is spot-on - there is no "universal reputation" list - all such lists have their own parameters and construction, much less timeliness, accuracy, etc.

Maxim Alzoba (FAITID):@Marika, please add to "Reputation is not a universal concept" and "a subject to ranking of a particular CyberSecurity organization"
