Joke Braeken:the document is now scrollable

Marilyn Cade:I do not think that we should be promoting gTLDs.

Marilyn Cade:We should focus on the core mission.

Vanda Scartezini:I was at phone tilla dobe allowed me to connect. sorry

Sylvia Cadena:I do not agree to support example 12

Erika Mann:Marilynn!

Erika Mann:Marilyn, I come back to you in a second.

Marilyn Cade:I hope I will now be able to speak.

judith hellerstein:I agree with Alan on this issue

judith hellerstein:on number 8

Maureen Hilyard:+1 Alan re 8 and 12

Julf Helsingius:I agree with the out of scope / marketing comments

judith hellerstein:I also agree with Alan on 12 and do not support either of them

Julf Helsingius:I don't agree with excluding something just because of business / financial risk

Marilyn Cade:We are not about creating new business creation. The ccNSO might want to think that also promoting their visibiity is important.

enoss:[sorry for being late] +1 re: 12; with 8, if it is work being done by a respected non-profit org

Jon Nevett:whether it is worthwhile, is irrelevant -- the issuse is whether it is within the mission related to the DNS. 8 is out, but an education campaign maybe contemplated in 12 should be ok

Alan Greenberg:@Julf, I added that as an aside. I di not think 8 is anywhere near our mission.

Julf Helsingius:Alan: I agree

Ching Chiao:<question> For "8", can we say that the CCWG will not support any commercial businesses / activities i.e. fund goes only to non-for-profit use

enoss:are we discussing only these two right now or others as well?

judith hellerstein:I think just these 2 right now

Julf Helsingius:isn't promoting domains and names "supporting commercial businesses / activities"?

Ching Chiao:Hi Elliott, just 8 and 12 for now

Sylvia Cadena:I think we are discussing the ones that got comments on the file about "not being supported" and the others were considered consistent

judith hellerstein:I have a question on 15 but will wait until we get there

Jon Nevett:"grants to support new gTLD applications" is contained in the Applicant Guidebook as a potential use of auction proceeds -- again let's not look at the specific merits of an example, but whether the categories might be ok

Julie Bisland:please mute your line when not speaking

enoss:@ching +1

Jon Nevett:For the record, I don't agree Erika

Vanda Scartezini:in other words may be...

Julf Helsingius>No, I was just agreeing

Marilyn Cade:We are not agreeing. we can park for later discussion. I do not support doing marketing for gTLDs.

Vanda Scartezini:Jon I believe this campaign shall be supported by ICANN itself

enoss:but then so are a near unlimited number of things

enoss:I think it is implied that this list has some relationship to the type/category of projects we view as appropriate

Erika Mann:Julf - can you hear us?

Julf Helsingius:I was simply agreeing

Hadia Elminiawi:hello all, sorry for joining late

Sylvia Cadena:I am ok with not supporting example 8 in particular, but I do not agree with the idea to exclude projects that have a sustainability plan which might imply commercial use.

enoss:both sylvia and I had a qualifier to 8

enoss:that made it ok I thought

Jon Nevett:The example is awareness not marketing -- or let's change the example to make it clear

Nadira AL-Araj:In fact, I suggested to keep those suggested project examples and list them in a new category as an example how they don't match ICANN mission.

judith hellerstein:Hi Jon, Awareness is a better term than marketing

Maureen Hilyard:I agree with Marilyn about the marketing intent within #12 being unacceptable

Alan Greenberg:I had a strong objection to 8 and I thought I heard the same from others.

judith hellerstein:I am against marketing but if they are going to revise the question to frame it as an awareness I am willing to take another look at it

Joke Braeken:As a reminder, it is not the objective to cover every possible project that could be considered consistent with ICANN's mission. The focus is on ensuring that examples are sufficiently clear to provide guidance on what types of projects are considered consistent with ICANN's mission and which ones are not considered consistent.

Vanda Scartezini:Judith Yes. that is my point. having general awareness is quite important for developing regions, but promoting new rounds for instance is for ICANN directly to support not this auction

Marilyn Cade:on point 22.

enoss:I agree

judith hellerstein:I agree with you on example 22

Erika Mann:Marilyn

Sylvia Cadena:I agree with Erika. I do not think the reserve replenishment should be listed as an example

Maureen Hilyard:Yes we hear you Marilyn

Sylvia Cadena:Yes, but it will not be a project that the community will submit. It will a board request, so it should not be on this list

Sylvia Cadena:Exactly. It is not a project.

judith hellerstein:I am against double dipping

judith hellerstein:I agree it is not a project

Marilyn Cade:I can not agree, the community could strongly support this.

Sylvia Cadena:A project will have a beginning and an end. A project will require ICANN to report back how it has manage its funds

Marilyn Cade:can someone describe what double dipping is? I have a long history of legal engagement, so perhaps someone can describe their view of double dipping, from a legal perspective?

Maureen Hilyard:We are keeping this list specifically to projects, so #22 can be deleted from the list although not totally from our other discussions

Vanda Scartezini:agree with Erika. we need the demand first

Sylvia Cadena:Exactly Maureen. That is the idea.

Jon Nevett:I agree that we delete 22 as an example, but not delete the concept

Marilyn Cade:perhaps Elliot can contact me off line?
