ICANN org Commitments

ICANN org is committed to accountability and transparency.



Current and easy-to-find information in all six U.N. languages is a vital part of achieving those commitments.

One of the vital ways we work to demonstrate and meet those commitments is through the availability and accessibility of content.

How Can ICANN org Increase Transparency of Our Public Info?



Coherent and consistent content strategy

- ⦿ Comprehensive taxonomy, information architecture, and content governance applied to external content.



Implementation of scalable infrastructure

- ⦿ Deployment of unified Document Management System (DMS) with taxonomy and information architecture.
- ⦿ Improved <https://www.icann.org> on a singular, scalable, and secure Content Management System (CMS).
 - Leverages new content strategy and new infrastructure.

Information Transparency Initiative (ITI) Goals

- ⦿ Create an integrated, ongoing, operational process to govern, preserve, organize, and secure ICANN's public content.
- ⦿ Build a foundation of content governance through consistent multilingual tagging, a functional information architecture, and enforced workflows.
- ⦿ Implement and enforce this governance through a new DMS.
- ⦿ Deploy new workflows and processes to ensure consistent, multilingual taxonomy for greater content findability and multifaceted search capabilities.
- ⦿ Establish a future-proof and content agnostic technology landscape.
- ⦿ Upgrade our technical infrastructure, and thereby serve our global community better through increased findability and accessibility of multilingual content.

ITI Goals (cont'd)

- ⦿ Create and enforce content governance and increase publishing speed through distributed content management, and improve content quality.
- ⦿ Develop a mobile first approach, ensure accessibility standards are met, and provide a translated user experience in the U.N. six languages.
- ⦿ Surface improved content and search to stakeholders through a new content management system (CMS), which will serve as the backbone for all external ICANN properties.

Benefits to the ICANN community and org



Improves findability, transparency, security, and quality of content.



Decreases yearly maintenance costs, and consolidates 15 separate external content properties.



Ensures content is future-proof and transferable to future platforms.



Lays foundation for ICANN shared ecosystem, enabling system-wide search and governance, further reducing maintenance costs.



Improves accessibility in the six U.N. languages.



Helps meet our commitments, reduces financial risk.

ITI Status Update

- ⦿ Creating consistent ICANN taxonomy, tagged over 9,000 pieces of public content through a combination of eyes-on audit and machine learning.
- ⦿ Building new technical infrastructures - DMS (Alfresco) and CMS (dotCMS), and integration between the two platforms.
- ⦿ Conducted interviews with ICANN community - Supporting Organization and Advisory Committee (SO/AC) leaders, registry and registrar operators, regional leaders including APRALO Chair, NextGen and Fellows, registrants, other stakeholders.
- ⦿ Launching <https://feedback.icann.org>, platform for community to provide input into ITI.
- ⦿ Testing DMS and CMS integration with improved ICANN Acronyms and Terms feature.
- ⦿ Upcoming releases – Registry Agreements, Announcements, Blogs.
