ICANN Update

In May, the ICANN Board held three public sessions and a public Board meeting during the Global Domains Division (GDD) meeting in Vancouver, Canada.

In addition, ICANN:

- Filed a case in Germany against EPAG, a Germany-based ICANN-accredited registrar part of the Tucows Group, on issues related to preserving WHOIS data. The German court provided their ruling on the WHOIS case for EPAG.
- Approved the proposed "[Temporary Specification for gTLD Registration Data](#)" in order to temporarily comply with the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).
- Released the [Final Proposed Draft version 4.0](#) of the Internationalized Domain Name (IDN) Implementation Guidelines.
- Announced an [agreement](#) with [DENIC eGas](#), an ICANN-designated agent, to support [Registrar Data Escrow](#) (RDE) services.
- Published the FY18 Q3 [Stakeholder Update](#) for the quarter ending 31 March 2018, as well as U.S. tax returns (Form 990) for the fiscal year ending 30 June 2017 for both [ICANN](#) and [Public Technical Identifiers \(PTI\)](#).
- Published the proposed [FY19 Operating Plan and Budget, and Five-Year Operating Plan update](#) as well as the [Report of Public Comments on ICANN's Reserve Fund: Proposed Replenishment Strategy](#).
- The Board approved the [FY19 Budget](#) on 30 May 2018.

The At-Large Advisory Committee (ALAC) ratified 4 Policy Advice Statements in May:

- [CCWG-Accountability WS2 Final Report](#) *The ALAC noted that the assurance of full consistency between all of the recommendations - which are noted in the report to be more than 100 - would depend primarily on the interpretation of the recommendations and the implementation plan. The ALAC recommends dedicating enough time to ensure inconsistencies do not result due to misinterpretation of the recommendations.*
- [Draft Final Report of the NomCom2 Review](#) *On the whole, the ALAC believes the ICANN NomCom system has been working well considering the significant challenges it faces. The ALAC made 8 general comments to improve the function of the NomCom, noting that while confidentiality needs to be maintained, whenever possible, open, transparent processes should be adopted to represent the multistakeholder nature of ICANN.*
- [Draft Project Plan for the Proposed Name Collision Analysis Project \(NCAP\)](#) *As the principle voice of end users within the ICANN community, the ALAC supported the SSAC in its efforts to address the issue of Name Collisions, while encouraging clarity on the SSAC's bidding process for work contemplated under the Draft Project Plan.*
- [ICANN Reserve Fund: Proposed Replenishment Strategy](#) *The ALAC supports the overall strategy, with several important conditions related to operational savings, auction proceeds, per-domain registrar fees and revenue.*

- As there was only a single candidate for the positions of APRALO Chair, APRALO ALAC Delegate to NomCom and APRALO ALAC Member, they were declared winners. An election was held for the position of Vice Chair, as there were two candidates.

Successful Completion of 2nd Edition of Afghanistan School on Internet Governance (AfSIG 2018)

The second edition of Afghanistan school on Internet Governance was organized by National IT Professionals Association of Afghanistan, in collaboration with Internet Society Afghanistan Chapter between 29 April - 1 May, 2018, in Kabul, Afghanistan. The event (AfSIG 2018) was supported by key national and international organizations, including the Ministry of Communication and Information Technology of Afghanistan, apTLD and ICANN.

The first two days of the School were conducted at Kardan University, while the 3rd day was jointly organized with ISOC Afghanistan Chapter on day zero of IGFA.

AfSIG 2018 was able to train 30 new students on Internet Governance related issues, with the help of 26 national and international speakers including APRALO Chair Satish Babu, and ALS member Amrita Choudhury, from CCAOI. For more details, visit [AfSIG](#).

Second Internet Governance Forum Afghanistan (IGFA 2018) Concludes Successfully

The second Internet Governance Forum Afghanistan(IGFA) 2018 was held in Kabul, Afghanistan from 1-3 May, 2018. The event was organized by the Internet Society Afghanistan, with the support of Commercial Law Development Program (CLDP), IO Global Internet Services, Grand Technology Resources (GTR), IGF Support Association (IGFSA), ICANN, Afghan Ministry of Communications and IT (MCIT), TechNation and TechTV.

"Day 0" of the event held sessions celebrating Girls in ICT. The key issues discussed include access and diversity, cyber security, youth and gender and emerging issues. The session format included a number of public forums that allowed the community to ask questions and provide suggestions for improvement. In addition, an Academy for Children between the ages of 6 and 12 was conducted to provide the children an opportunity to engage and ask questions about the Internet.

The event was attended by over 300 participants from different stakeholder communities with simultaneous interpretation in English, Pashto and Dari along with remote participation facilities. Keynote speakers included Mr. Shahzad Aryobee, Minister of Communications and IT, Mr. Mohammad Najeeb Azizi, Chairman Afghanistan Telecom Regulatory Authority (ATRA) and leaders from country's civil society, private sector, academia and technical communities. International speakers, including Mr. Chengetai Masango, Program and Technology Manager IGF Secretariat, Amrita Choudhury, Director CCAOI, Marilyn Cade, CEO mCade Strategies, and Anja Gengo, NRI Focal Point, took part in person, and several others spoke at the event remotely.

ISOC Palestine Digital Self-Defense Initiative

ISOC Nepal Initiatives

- Internet Society Nepal organized an awareness event on "Card Fraud and its Mitigation" in Banepa, Kavre. The event was attended by 33 participants representing different sectors, including the finance institutions, law enforcement, journalism, academia and end users. The main objective of the program was to sensitize people about different types of card fraud and its mitigation; and to raise awareness about the safer card use among major stakeholders including cardholders, merchant, issuer banks and acquirer banks. The program was organized in partnership Budhanilkantha Jaycees and Kavrepalanchowk Jaycees. Amar Rajbhandari, General Secretary, Internet Society Nepal and E-banking Head, Machhapuchhre Bank Limited presented on the types of fraudulent activity common in Nepal, security measures to be taken by cardholders, investigation procedures, security measures to be taken by the merchants and banks, etc. For more details visit this [link](#).
