- 1. Organise a ccNSO Members Meeting at every ICANN meeting
- 2. The Meeting Programme Working Group should explore the possibility to organise a 1-day ccNSO Members Meeting during the second ICANN meeting of the year.
- 3. Keep the ccNSO Members Meeting as a single stream, and do not organise parallel sessions.
- 4. When putting together the agenda for the ccNSO Members meeting, the Meeting Programme Working Group should keep in mind those priorities highlighted via the survey, namely:
  - a. developing relations between ccTLDs
  - b. providing updates by and to the ccTLD community
- 5. The Meeting Programme Working Group should attempt avoiding *unnecessary* overlap or duplications with regional organisations' meetings.
- 6. The ccNSO council should ensure that the joint sessions with other supporting organisations and advisory committees at public ICANN meetings are a valuable experience for all parties, in terms of their objectives and timing.
