

Amendment to the Rules of Procedure

Based on the ALAC's need to incorporate individual users into our current Operating Principles, the LACRALO's Governance Working Group submits this amendment proposal to be discussed within our region by the ALSs which constitute it and to be immediately incorporated into its approval in our internal laws at LACRALO.

The amendment is proposed in Article 2 of these operating principles.

The current Article 2 specifically states the following:

“2. The LACRALO shall promote the formation of user groups and their accreditation by the ALAC. Nevertheless, mechanisms shall be maintained to ensure that the regional users not integrated into ALSs can express their opinion on the development of ICANN policies.

The result of the proposed amendment would read as follows:

2.- LACRALO shall promote the formation of user groups and their accreditation by the ALAC.

LACRALO shall facilitate the participation of individual users not related to any At Large structure, residents in the Latin America and the Caribbean region, to engage them in the discussion and creation of policies, committing them to promote their participation in activities within ICANN.

The participation methods of the ALSs and individual users not related to any At-Large structure shall be defined in a specific section in the Rules of Procedure.
