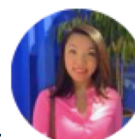

EPDP on Temporary Specification for gTLD Registration Data - Initiation Request and Charter DT meeting

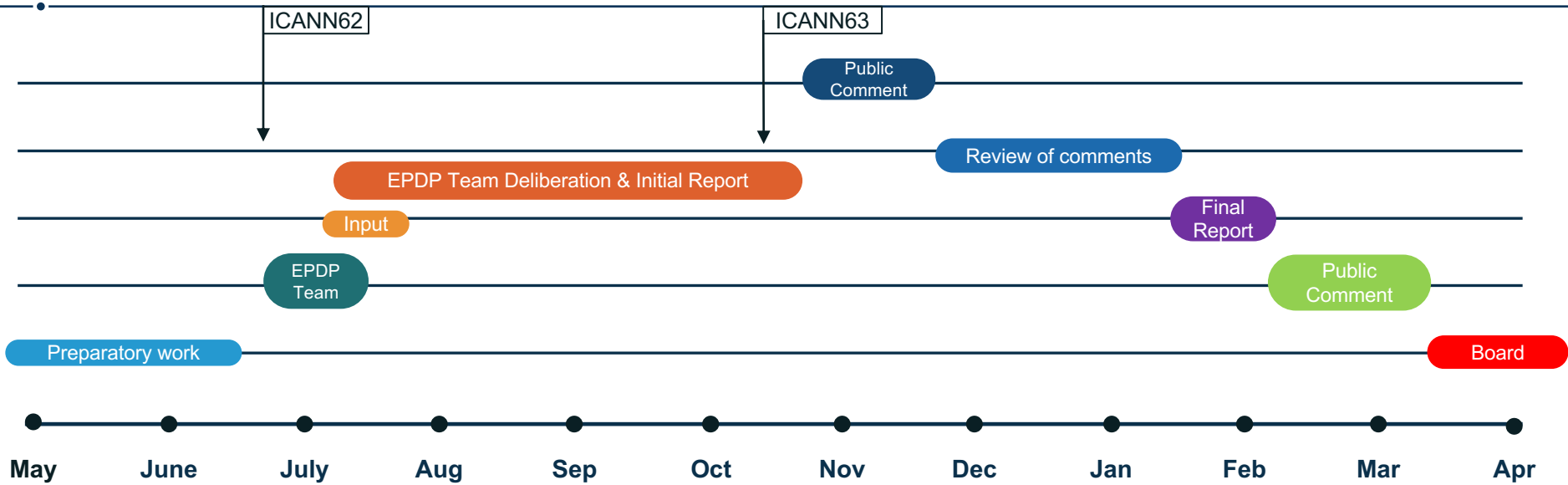
Current Status

- ⦿ ICANN Board adopted a temporary specification on 17 May 2018, with an effective date of 25 May 2018.
- ⦿ The adoption of the Temporary Specification triggered an obligation on the GNSO Council to undertake a policy development process to confirm, or not, the Temporary Specification as Consensus Policy within 12 months of the Board's adoption of the Temporary Specification.
- ⦿ Given the time constraints the GNSO Council agreed that the Expedited Policy Development Process (EPDP) provides the best opportunity to meet the goal.
- ⦿ The GNSO Council formed a Drafting Team (DT) to develop EPDP Initiation Request and Team Charter, and identified Council Leads for specific topics.
- ⦿ A placeholder motion to approve the Initiation Request and the Charter for the EPDP is on the agenda for the GNSO Council meeting this Wednesday.

Objective of the Session

- Objective of the meeting: Continue deliberations on proposed EPDP Charter and reach agreement on proposed approach for different aspects of the charter.
- Key subjects to be addressed:
 - Composition of EPDP Team / Membership Criteria
 - EPDP Team Leadership
 - EPDP Scope (mission, purposes, objectives, goals, deliverables, timeframes)
 - EPDP Decision-making methodologies
 - EPDP Status reporting
 - Problem/Issue Escalation & Resolution Processes
- Factor in input received during Monday's HIT session.

Draft EPDP Timeline



- Prep work, incl EPDP Initiation Request & Charter adoption
- Formation of EPDP Team; shortly after ICANN62
- Input from SO/ACs & SG/Cs
- EPDP Team Deliberation & Publication of Initial Report
- Public Comment on Initial Report
- Review of Public Comment & Submission of Final Report
- Council consideration of Final Report
- Public Comment prior to Board consideration
- Board consideration

To Summarize

365 days available to carry out all required steps in an EPDP. Draft timeline assumes first meeting of EPDP at ICANN62 at the latest.

Review of all Rights Protection Mechanisms in all gTLDs PDP Working Group (1 of 3)

Overview

The GNSO's Review of All Rights Protection Mechanisms (RPMs) Policy Development Process (PDP) Working Group (WG) was chartered in March 2016 to conduct a two-phased PDP. In Phase One, the WG is reviewing all the RPMs that were developed for the 2012 New gTLD Program. The WG is conducting extensive data collection on the Sunrise and Claims RPMs. In addition, the WG is identifying additional data needs and inquiries concerning Uniform Rapid Suspension (URS).

What to Expect at ICANN62

The RPM PDP WG is holding 1 Face-to-Face session today, during which Sub Teams will present to the WG the results of the responses from URS practitioners, the status of the data collection on the Sunrise and Claims RPMs, and an update on the analysis of related documents.

New gTLD Auction Proceeds Cross-Community Working Group F2F meeting

Overview

The new gTLD Program established auctions as a mechanism of last resort to resolve string contention (Competition between 2 or more applicants for TLDs). The ICANN community has chartered a Cross-Community Working Group (CCWG). The CCWG has been tasked to develop a proposal for eventual consideration by the ICANN Board on the mechanism(s) that should be created to allocate the new gTLD Auction Proceeds.

What to Expect at ICANN62

The CCWG is holding 1 Face-to-Face session today, during which it will review mechanism descriptions, proposed responses to remaining charter questions, and the work plan and next steps
