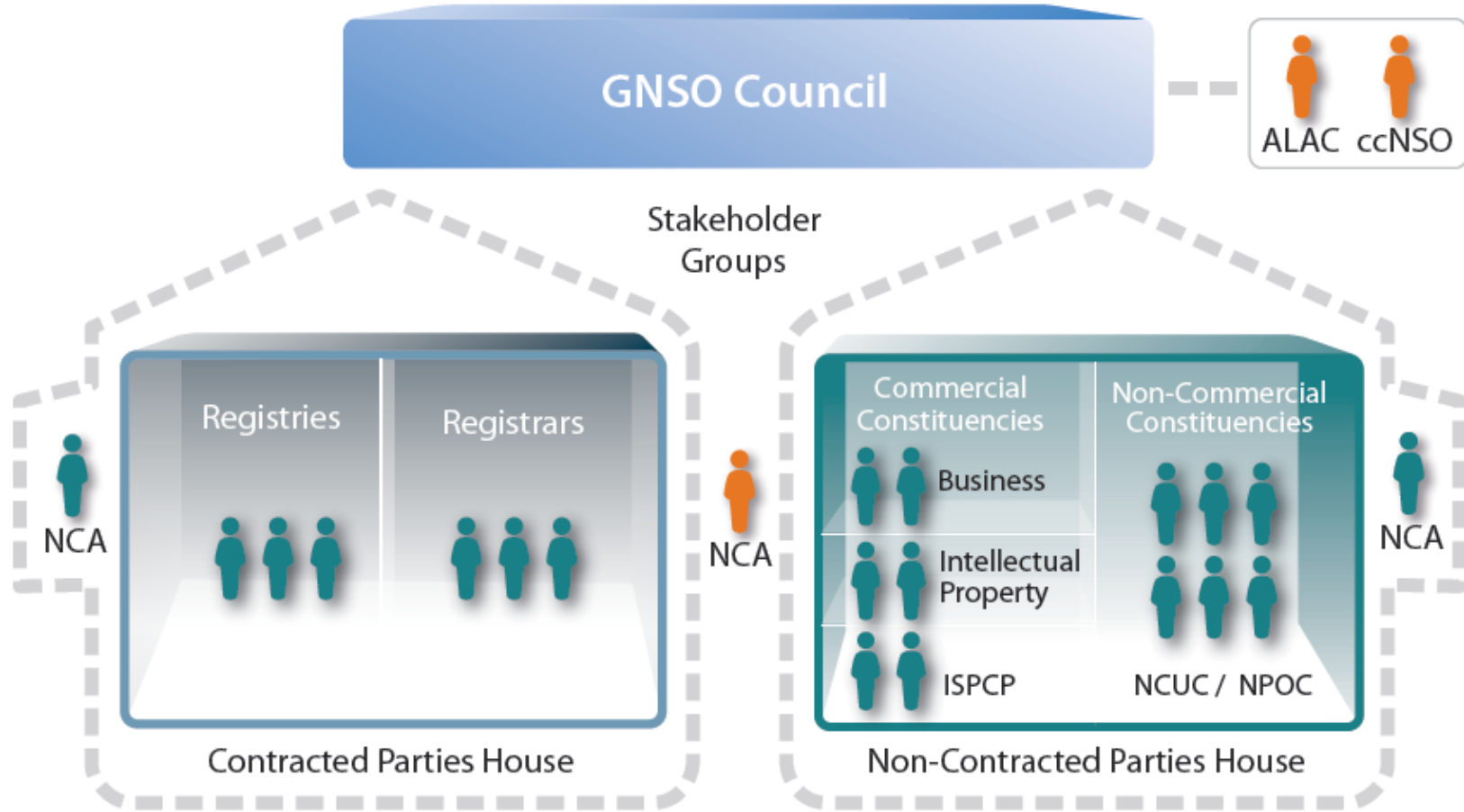

Review of all Rights Protection Mechanisms in all gTLDs PDP Working Group (2 of 3 and 3 of 3)

Overview

The GNSO's Review of All Rights Protection Mechanisms (RPMs) Policy Development Process (PDP) Working Group (WG) was chartered in March 2016 to conduct a two-phased PDP. In Phase One, the WG is reviewing all the RPMs that were developed for the 2012 New gTLD Program. The WG is conducting extensive data collection on the Sunrise and Claims RPMs. In addition, the WG is identifying additional data needs and inquiries concerning Uniform Rapid Suspension (URS).

What to Expect at ICANN62

The RPM PDP WG is holding 2 Face-to-Face sessions today, during which the WG will engage in a discussion on procedural issues with the Uniform Rapid Suspension (URS) and Phase One, and a Sub Team will hold a working session to review responses to questions for URS providers.

New gTLD Subsequent Procedures PDP WG

Overview

Community efforts, such as a PDP and various reviews, are underway to take into consideration the 2012 New gTLD round and seek ways to improve, refine, or develop new policy recommendations for new gTLDs, acknowledging that there is existing new gTLD policy from the GNSO's 2007 Final Report on the Introduction of New gTLDs.

- The New gTLD Subsequent Procedures PDP WG is holding 1 Face-to-Face session today, during which it will recap previous sessions and the week overall, discuss input to red-lined Initial Report, wrap up for the week and discuss next steps for the WG.

CC - Geographic Names at the Top-Level

Overview

Work Track 5 has been established as a sub-team for the New gTLD Subsequent Procedures PDP WG, to focus on singular topic.
