Increase the level of involvement (1)

Questions

- Open with a question
- Allow for questions from the audience throughout the presentation
- Invite the audience to type questions in the Zoom chat
- Ask for reactions, do not only ask for questions



Increase the level of involvement (1)

Measure the temperature

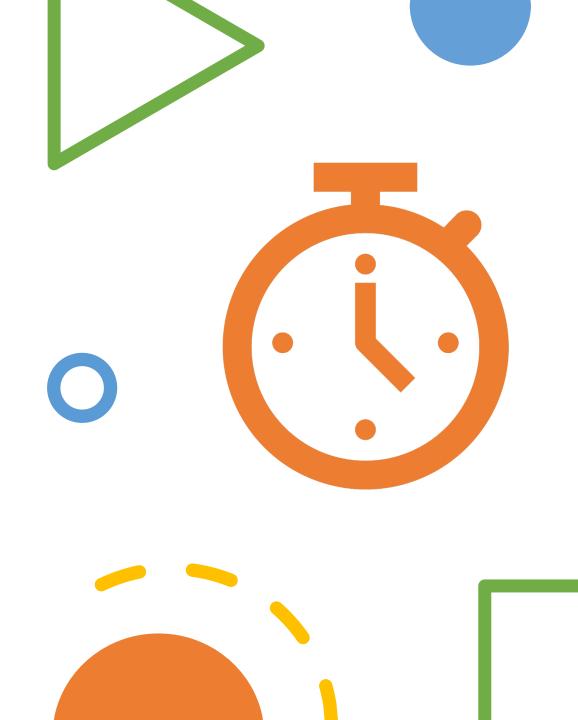
- Use the non-verbal signal is Zoom (green & red ticks)
- Ask for feedback on a certain topic prior to a presentation, and see whether the feedback changed after the presentation

Important!

- Stay focused and brief: global audience!
- Stick to the time allocated to your presentation
- Allow time for dialogue and involve your audience
- Do not read your slides aloud
- Keep the layout of the slide deck simple
- Use visuals
- Video/Audio: let the ccNSO Secretariat know prior to the meeting
- Submit your slide deck on time
