

What are ccTLDs?

- country code Top Level Domains
- 2-character TLDs: .jp (Japan), .ke (Kenia)
- country, territory, or other geographic location (ISO 3166-1)




Why are ccTLDs important?

160.6 million ccTLDs

210.1 million gTLDs

Top 10 largest TLDs by number of reported domains contain **7 ccTLDs**: .com, .tk, .cn, .de, .net, .uk, .org,.nl, .ru, .icu
















ccNSO – the global platform for ccTLDs



What is the ccNSO?

ICANN Bylaws, Article 10:

ICANN Policy Development body, which shall be responsible for:

- Developing and recommending to the Board global policies relating to countrycode top-level domains;
- Nurturing consensus across the ccNSO community, including the name-related activities of ccTLDs;
- Coordinating with other ICANN Supporting Organizations, committees, and constituencies under ICANN.

The ccNSO may also engage in other activities authorized by its members.

Any 2-letter ccTLD who has agreed in writing to be a ccNSO member






Who can be a volunteer?



IDN Country Code Top-Level Domains




