GDPR

General Data Protection Regulation

Approved by the EU Parliament 14 April 2016 Took effect 25 May 2018 Replaces the Earlier EU Directive

Applies (apart from the EU), to all companies processing personal data of data subjects residing in the EU regardless of company location and regardless of where the processing of personal information takes place

Penalties: Up to 4% annual turnover or 20 Mil Euros (whichever the greater)

GDPR

- Consent clearly stated
- Breach notification, within 72 hours
- Right to access personal information
- Right to be Forgotten
- Data Portability
- Privacy by Design
- Data Protection

Temporary Specification for gTLD Registration Data

Highlighting Changes from the WHOIS requirements:

- Application to European Economic Area, with option to extend globally
- Retention of collection of WHOIS data BUT tiered access
- Applies to all domain name registration personal data in the WHOIS system (legal and natural persons
- WHOIS personal data that is displayed
 - name
 - Organisatioon
 - State/province
 - Anonymised email address or web form

GDPR and Access

 Users with a legitimate and proportionate purpose for accessing the non- public Personal Data will be able to request such access through Registrars and Registry Operators.
