Status Update

- GDPR Privacy & Proxy Service Provider Accreditation Agreement (PPAA) review complete
 - Analysis is ongoing
 - PPAA markup is not a final proposal: For discussion purposes only
 - Markup addresses contractual issues, but broader questions also identified
- IRT to review markup and discussion questions
 - Proposed timeline: 2 weeks
- Once IRT review is complete, will proceed to public comment
 - Ideally before ICANN63, but depends on extent of discussions
 - Any Policy questions could be escalated to GNSO Council
- Session is planned for ICANN63 in Barcelona



Summary: PPAA Markup

- Section 3.5.3.3.
 - Required provisions for Customer agreements re: data processing
- IP Framework Specification
 - Proposed new reason for refusal to disclose—reasonable basis for believing disclosure would violate relevant data protection laws (Section 3.3.7)
- Data Processing Specification
- Non-substantive copy edits throughout
- GDPR-related matters under consideration
 - Defining data to be collected, purpose
 - Controller arrangements amongst Provider/ICANN/Registrar
 - How to manage provisions that are similar to Temp Spec or that could be impacted by ePDP?



How should we approach drafting provisions that are similar to the Temp Spec, which could be impacted by the ePDP?



Does the IRT believe proceeding to Public Comment Period at this stage will provide a benefit to the community to discuss the policy implementation in parallel with the ePDP?



Are disclosure frameworks intended to give Providers no or limited discretion on disclosure if framework requirements are met?

What should requirements be for logging disclosure requests?
