ccNSO Sessions: What to expect?



The Country Code Names Supporting Organization (ccNSO) program begins on Tuesday, 13 October, with the ccNSO Members Meeting. The first session will focus on governance of the ccNSO, and the second session will provide members with an opportunity to meet with candidates for the ccNSO Council.

On Wednesday, 14 October, there is a meeting by the Internet Governance Liaison Committee (IGLC), followed by presentations and panel discussions about the country code top-level domain (ccTLD) experiences with the COVID-19 pandemic. On Thursday, 15 October, the Strategic and Operational Planning Committee (SOPC) will meet, followed by a question and answer session where the ccNSO members and others have an opportunity to interact with the candidates for ICANN Board Seat 12, preparing the ccNSO membership for elections in November. The final session of the ccNSO Members Meeting will be held on Tuesday, 20 October, when ccNSO members and the broader ccTLD community participate in a question and answer session with the ccTLD-related ICANN Board members.

<u>Tech Day</u>, a workshop open to all community members with an interest in technical, operational, and security topics, will be held on Monday, 19 October. The <u>ccNSO</u> <u>Council</u> will meet on Wednesday, 21 October 2020.
