ccNSO & Universal Acceptance: next steps

Universal Acceptance (UA) is cornerstone to a digitally inclusive and multilingual Internet, ensuring all domain names and email addresses - in any language, script, or using any new or long TLD - are accepted equally by all Internet-enabled applications, devices, and systems.

In December, a ccNSO workshop further explored the expectations by the ccTLD community regarding potential ccNSO action on UA, and how to organize next efforts. A second workshop is expected to be held in January '23. The ccNSO Council will then develop a plan which will be presented to the ccTLD community at ICANN76.

Third ccNSO Policy Development Process



Initial Report on the ccNSO PDP Review Mechanism is out for public comments

The third ccNSO Policy Development Process Review Mechanism Working Group (ccPDP3-RM) has completed its initial draft report on policy proposals for a mechanism to review specific decisions pertaining to the delegation, transfer, revocation, and retirement of country code top-level domains (ccTLDs). We seek your input and comments on the initial proposed policy. Comments close 24 January 2023 | 23:59 UTC.

Following the Public Comments, staff will summarize the input received. The ccPDP3-RM working group will then review the comments and will consider them in its ongoing deliberations. As part of the process, in a later stage, there will be a ccNSO members vote on the adoption of the proposed policy.

ccPDP3-RM: What is the policy about and how will it benefit ccTLDs?

The objective of the policy is to offer ccTLD managers and applicants for new ccTLDs - as direct customers of the IANA Naming Function - an independent review mechanism (ccRM) for specifically identified IANA Function Operator (IFO) decisions.

This Policy is directed at ICANN and the IFO as the entity that performs the IANA Naming Functions with respect to ccTLDs. The ccPDP3-RM WG recommends that all disputes and claims regarding the delegation, transfer, revocation and retirement of ccTLDs remain and are excluded from ICANN's Reconsideration Request Process and the Independent Review Process.

Planning for ICANN76

The ICANN76 Community Forum runs from 11 to 16 March in Cancun, Mexico. Prep Week is being held 27 February to 1 March.

The comprehensive schedule will be published 17 Feb 2023.
