### Primary ALAC and At-Large E-mail Lists

The ALAC and At-Large use e-mail as a primary communications vehicle. This document describes the primary e-mail lists and specifies their use for particular applications. It does not cover work group lists or others setup up to address specific topics or purposes

#### List name: ALAC

<b>Purpose</b>	Primary mailing list for conducting ALAC business
<b>Members</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• ALAC Members</li><li>• RALO Leaders</li><li>• <del>ALAC appointed Liaisons to other groups</del> <u>Advisors to the ALT as defined in the ALAC Rules of Procedure Paragraph 3.5</u></li><li>• ALAC Liaisons from other <u>ICANN</u> groups</li><li>• <u>Incumbent in ICANN Board Seat 15</u> (Board member selected by At-Large)</li><li>• <u>Chairs of key ALAC Work Teams on the recommendation of the ALAC Leadership team</u></li><li>• ICANN staff working with ALAC/At-Large</li><li>• Past ALAC Members, at their choice, and <del>regularly-periodically</del> re-affirmed-<del>(nominally annually)</del></li><li>• <u>Past RALO Leadership, at their choice, and regularly-periodically re-affirmed-(nominally annually)</u></li><li>• <u>Past occupants of ICANN Board Seat 15 at his/her choice</u></li><li>• Others by the explicit decision of the ALAC</li></ul>
<b>Who may send</b>	Any list member
<b>Subscription Method</b>	Staff subscribed
<b>De-subscription</b>	Staff intervention required
<b>Archived</b>	Yes, and publicly viewable
<b>Comments</b>	There has been discussions regarding allowing others to be able to receive e-mails instead of looking at the archive, but neither the concept nor the implementation has been approved.

11 **List name: ALAC-INTERNAL**

<b>Purpose</b>	Primarily for use of the ALAC for matters which must either remain reasonably confidential or are related to ALAC social events or travel plans.
<b>Members</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ALAC Members</li> <li>• RALO Leader</li> <li>• <del>ALAC Liaisons to the ccNSO, GNSO and SSAC Advisors to the ALT as defined in the ALAC Rules of Procedure Paragraph 3.5</del></li> <li>• Incumbent in ICANN Board 15 (Board member selected by At-Large)</li> <li>• ICANN staff working with ALAC/At-Large</li> <li>• Others by the explicit decision of the ALAC</li> </ul>
<b>Who may send</b>	Any list member
<b>Subscription Method</b>	Staff subscribed
<b>De-subscription</b>	Staff intervention required
<b>Archived</b>	Yes, but viewable only by list members. NOTE: new list members will have access to the entire history of posting.

12 **List name: ALAC-ExCom**

<b>Purpose</b>	Primarily for use of the ALAC Leadership Team and ALAC-appointed liaisons to other ICANN.
<b>Members</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ALAC Leadership Team</li> <li>• <del>ALAC Liaisons to the ccNSO, GNSO and SSAC Advisors to the ALT as defined in the ALAC Rules of Procedure Paragraph 3.5</del></li> <li>• Incumbent in ICANN Board 15 (Board member selected by At-Large)</li> <li>• ICANN staff working with ALAC/At-Large</li> <li>• Others by the explicit decision of the ALAC</li> </ul>
<b>Who may send</b>	No restriction, but non-members are moderated. This was done to allow other ALAC members and RALO leaders to send without having to explicitly list them as allowed senders. It has rarely been used for that purpose and there has been no known abuse.
<b>Subscription Method</b>	Staff subscribed
<b>De-subscription</b>	Staff intervention required
<b>Archived</b>	Yes, and publicly viewable
<b>Comments</b>	<del>This list will need to be renamed due to the change from Executive Committee to ALAC Leadership Team. The list name reflects the former name of the ALT but remains unchanged to ensure that mailing list archives are preserved.</del>

<b>Purpose</b>	Mailing list used for formal announcements related to the ALAC and At-Large.

<b>Who may send</b>	Any list member
<b>Subscription Method</b>	See Members
<b>De-subscription</b>	Anyone may de-subscribe without staff intervention
<b>Archived</b>	Yes, and publicly viewable
<b>Comments</b>	Level to which subject matter is strictly limited to ICANN matters is at the discretion of the ALAC, but few controls are <del>exhibited</del> <u>have been put in place in the past</u> . Topics typically include ICANN and Internet governance in general

- 32 • All list members may have alternate address(es) in the list from which they can send and/or  
 33 receive e-mails
- 34 • All lists are generally carried out in English unless otherwise noted
- 35 • Incoming ALAC Members, RALO Leadership, Liaisons and Seat 15 Board members should  
 36 be subscribed to the appropriate lists once their selections are publicly announced.
- 37 • Subscription ~~by staff~~ to the one or both LAC-Discuss lists based on personal language  
 38 preference.

39 **Approved Distribution Lists**

40 The ALAC Rules of Procedure refers to the mechanisms used to distribute certain type of e-mail  
 41 as Approved Distribution Lists. The mechanisms reference may be ~~ALAC~~-ALAC mailing lists or  
 42 individual user communications.

<u>ALAC Consensus Calls via e-mail</u>	<u>ALAC unless confidentiality requires ALAC.</u>
Selection of ALAC Chair and ALAC Leadership Team (Ordinary and Extraordinary)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>ALAC</li> <li>ALAC-ANNOUNCE</li> </ul>
ALAC Appointees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>ALAC</li> <li>ALAC-ANNOUNCE</li> <li>Other lists or direct personal e-mails may be used as appropriate to the specifics of the position to be filled.</li> </ul>
ALAC Leadership Team Member Recall	ALAC-INTERNAL or Personal e-mails as appropriate. If the recall is successful, a summary outcome will be distributed on the ALAC and ALAC-ANNOUNCE lists. For an unsuccessful Recall, the ALAC shall decide if a public statement of the attempted Recall is made.
Removal of an ALAC member	ALAC-INTERNAL or Personal e-mails as appropriate. For an unsuccessful Removal, the ALAC shall decide if a public statement of the attempted <u>Recall Removal</u> is made.
