- Early 2015: Planning the review started
- May 2016: ITEMS International select to carry out review
- January 2017: Draft Report issued
- May 2017: Final Report issues
- September 2017: Feasibility Assessment & Implementation Plan
- October 2017: Board Organizational Effectiveness Committee (OEC) ask for “Mapping” between Issues and ALAC Proposals
- December 2017: Staff delivered Mapping
- April 2018: ALAC delivered its revised mapping entitled “At-Large Review Implementation Overview Proposal”
- June 2018: Board approves At-Large Review Implementation Overview Proposal

Targets:

 - ALSes: Great source of potential workers
