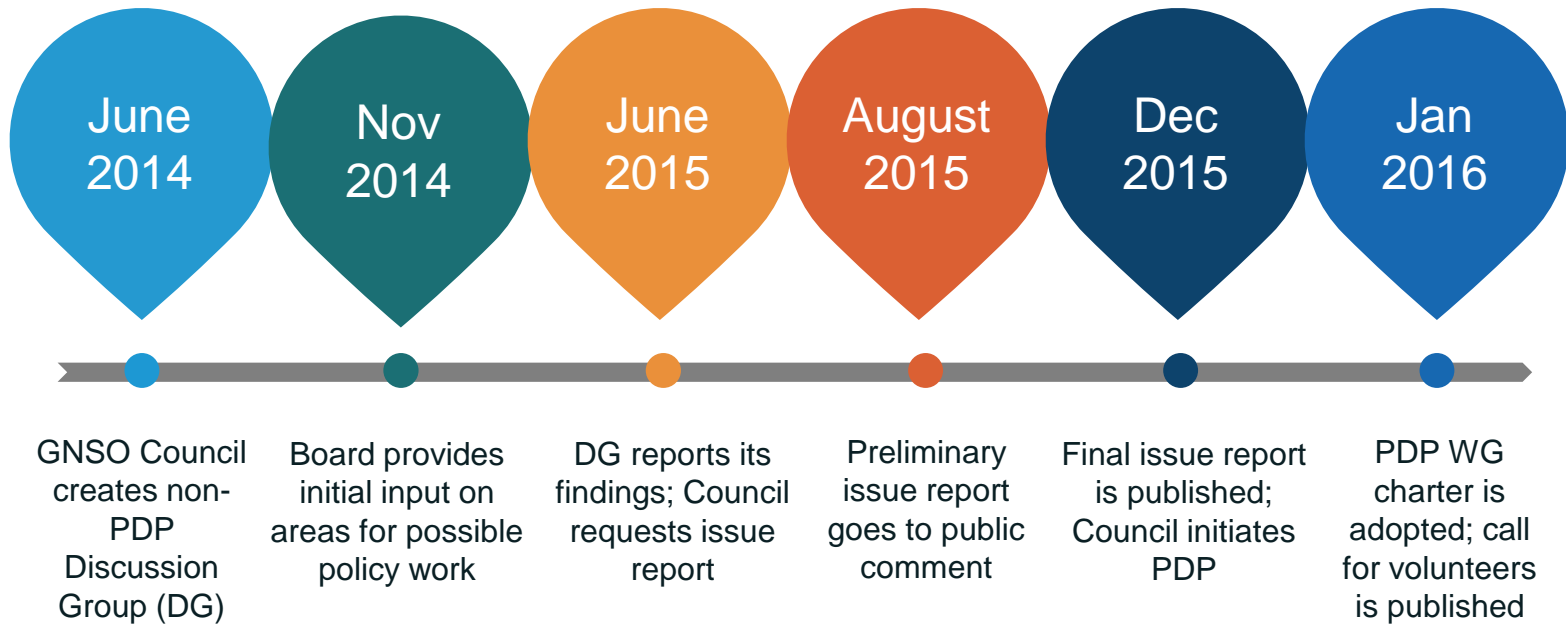




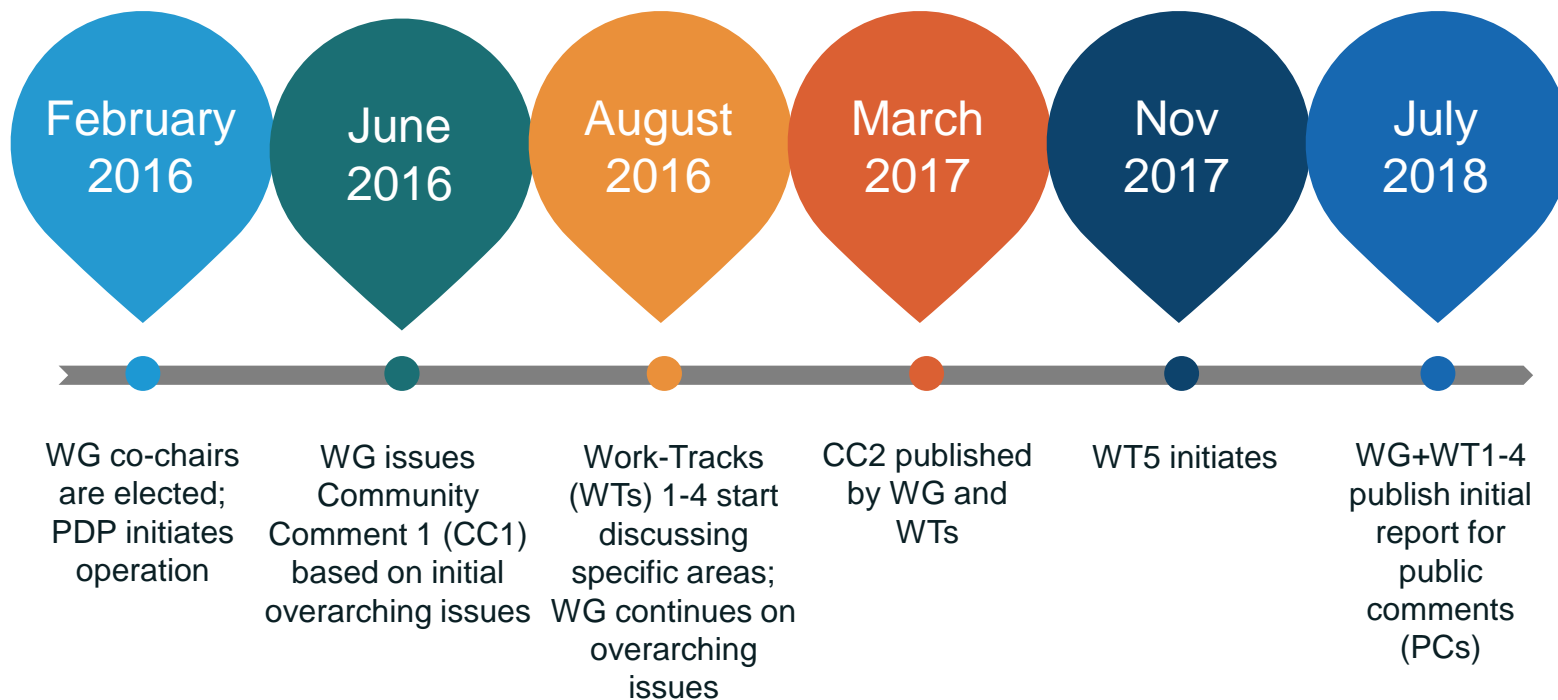

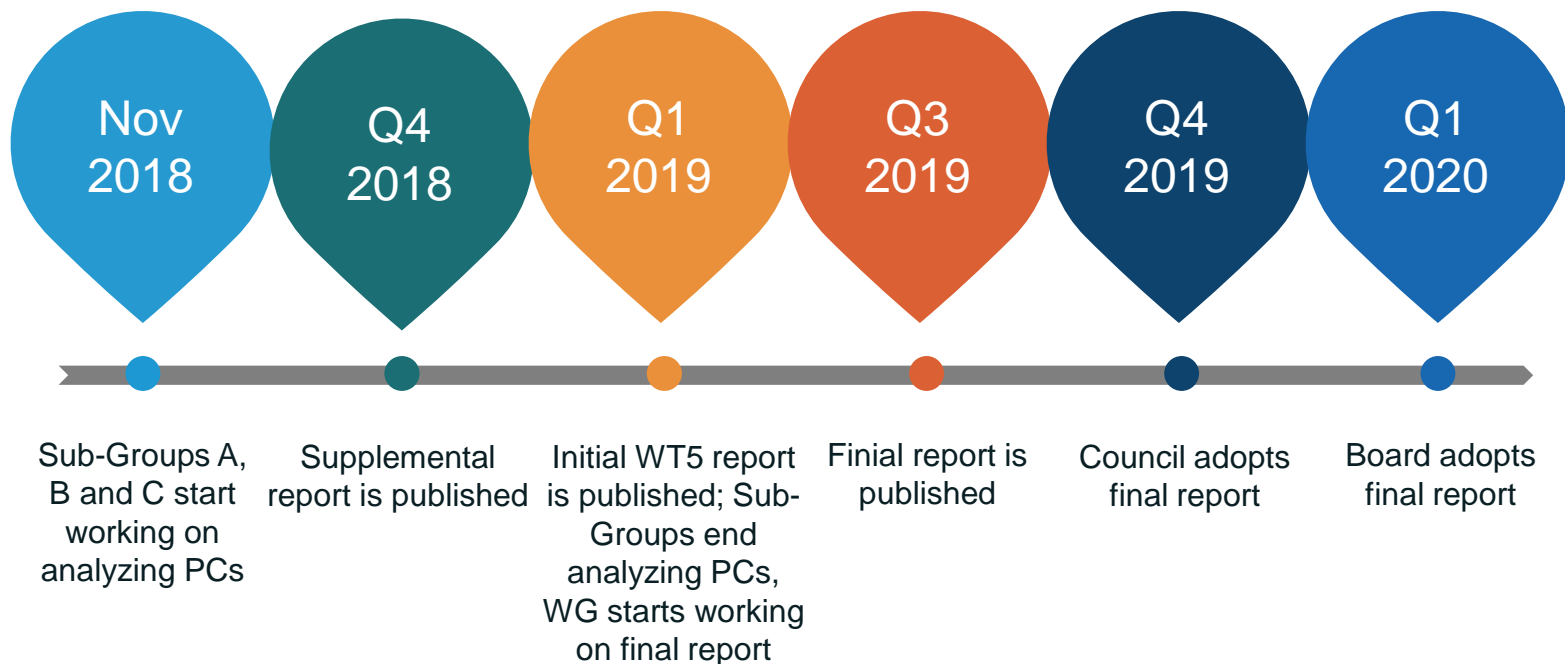
History of Subsequent Procedures

Possible future of Subsequent Procedures



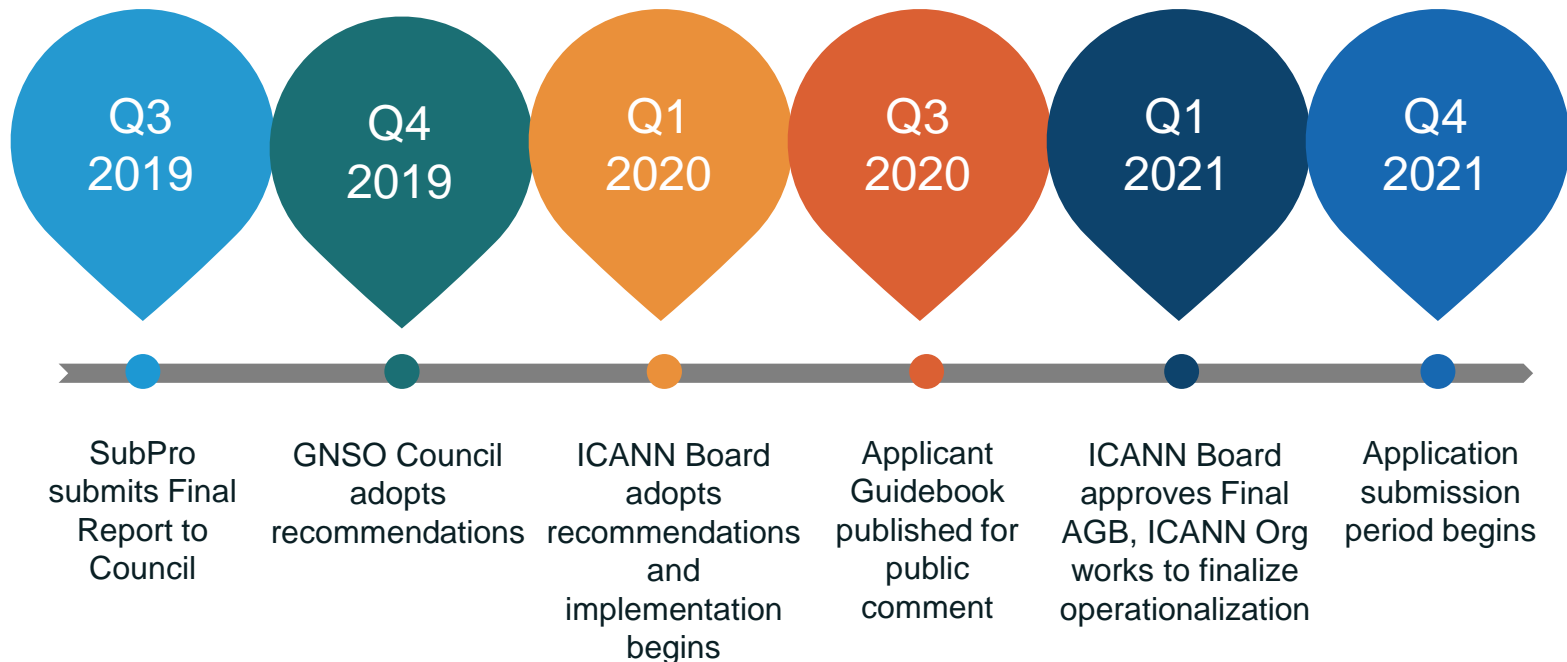
Possible Path to Subsequent Procedures

SubPro Supplemental Report

- 5 themes identified by WG as not fully covered by WG/WT1-4 Initial Report
 - Auctions: Mechanism of Last Resort
 - Private Resolution of Contention Sets (including Private Auctions)
 - Role of Application Comment
 - Change Requests
 - Registrar Support for New gTLDs
- Registrar support is a theme close to home for LAC region
- Public comment period for the supplemental report is coming soon

Possible Path to Subsequent Procedures

While it is difficult to predict when the New gTLD Program will commence with any level of certainty, the above timeline is a possible path based on personal opinion (“best educated guess”). It also serves as a reminder of some of the likely and necessary steps to reach that point.

SubPro Timeline Risk Factors

There is a dependency between SubPro PDP and RPM PDP Phase 1

- Current forecast for RPM Phase 1 is Q2 2019

CCT-RT report was only recently finalized

- If SubPro account of such report trigger new activities, there could be delay

NCAP (Name Collision Analysis Project) is still under unsure timeline

- SubPro leadership does not see it now as a dependency
- Project results could change that, though
- ICANN Org could choose doing a single implementation of NCAP and SubPro
