 Carlton Samuels:@Spam: They want us all to believe that everybody just reads headers!
 Carlton Samuels:Here's what I wrote in the At-Large Skype chat pertaining to the DPI issue: "Yes, Evan gets it. Here's the thing and let's use the DPI matter for argument's sake. That DPI kerfuffle is purely bullshit. Think the movie Casablanca. Most everybody in Dubai knows a Captain Renault moment when they hear it: "I'm shocked, shocked to find that gambling is going on in here"...this said as he took his winnings from the man. What was being played out you ask? Purely that the proposers, some of them card-carrying members of 'rendition' teams, are trumping their 'morally superior' others and 'go open' for tools they know damn well their 'betters' already deploy in one or other guise. These guys who are signatories to the DPI proposal read and watch what's going on in 3-4 languages. They know that the British government, likely purveyors of enlightened governance in far off places and territories, proposed a law that literally compelled DPI! They know the thinking in LHR is not far from theirs.

They have a sense of what must be done when they read words used such as 'verify' and 'validate'. Sure, there are other interests. But it would serve their top-of-mind and coincident ones to go along with ETNO. ETNO as spear chuckers find common ground with the control freaks! They just don't give a tinker's damn what we think. Our fellas now....well....

 Cheryl Langdon-Orr:and I suspect Sally and her team are well aware (now) of just that...
 Sandra Hoferichter:):sorry for referring to an ICANN Academy

Carlton Samuels:Lost my connection
Heidi Ullrich:Will call you back, Carlton
Carlton Samuels:Thanks Heidi
avri:Hi, yeah, i was there for both WTSA and WCIT. I have a different view than OCL.
avri:ICANN was not at the WCIT. And the WCIT was not about ICANN, at all.
Carlton Samuels:@Avri: Can you do voice? Would love to hear....soon as I'm back on please :-)
Evan Leibovitch:@JJS... thankfully, most graphite in pencils doesn't contain lead anymore
Sandra Hoferichter:most graphite in pencils doesn't contain lead anymore ---what does it mean:)
Holly Raiche:From what I heard, some of the proposals did suggest the ITU should have a role in naming/numbering - which is ICANN. Not sure how far that got
avri:Carlton: I suppose I could, I am only using Adobe. but I don't see much reason in it.
Carlton Samuels:Back on voice bridge
Heidi Ullrich:Welcome back, Carlton
avri:ICANN, like civil society, was a meta-delegation
Wolf Ludwig:Strongly agree, JJ!
Holly Raiche:No - it absolutely does NOT sound mild. We had a filtering proposal here - which has been abandoned - when both the technical and other issues with DPI were appreciated
Cheryl Langdon-Orr:were concerned about DPI in the antipodeas as well JJS rest assured
avri:Holly: yes some of the contribution coming in were. but once the truce between ITU and ICANN was sung, peace ensued and ICANN issues were actually off the docket. the rest of the Internet was still on the agenda, but not ICANN, that turf was off limits.
Carlton Samuels:@Avri: I understand your reluctance but I wish you would speak though..
Evan Leibovitch:@JJS +1
Heidi Ullrich:Avri, would you like a dial out/
Heidi Ullrich:?
Holly Raiche:@ Avri - thanks - and nice it was off the agenda
Yaovi Atohou:I am disconnected
Carlton Samuels:@JJS: DPI is a GRAVE matter personally. What I'm very much in favour of is a 'full and frank' discussion on it
Heidi Ullrich:we could invite Fadi and Sally to such a panel or webinar
avri:nope, i think i am fine, computer should work for talking when i need to.
Heidi Ullrich:will dial out to you, Yaovi
Heidi Ullrich:as well as the GSE Vice Presidents who were at the WCIT
Wolf Ludwig:Speak up, Tijani, please!
Cheryl Langdon-Orr:I can not hear Tijani at all sorry
Juan Manuel Rojas:It sounds far away Tijani
Heidi Ullrich:Tijani - we need a way to make ICANN more international. WE also need IANA to be more international.
Cheryl Langdon-Orr:thanks Heidi
Heidi Ullrich:Tijani - I am against any control of the internet
Heidi Ullrich:Tijani - I think we need to work together in At-Large to raise awareness in ICANN
Yaovi Atohou:i am back
Heidi Ullrich:Tijani - we need to do more to link our internet and the other views (confirm)
Heidi Ullrich:Welcome back, Yaovi
Cheryl Langdon-Orr:Thanks Heidi those points are VERY important Tijani YES
Heidi Ullrich:Good connection, Yaovi.
Tijani BEN JEMAA:Thank you Heidi
Tijani BEN JEMAA:and sorry for the bad quality of my line
avri:Carlton: DPI has been a fact of life for a while. Definitely should have serious conversations on it, but more and more people are doing it all the time.
avri:The ITU will not take over the Internet, it will just control it though maybe round about paths.
avri:A WCIT, the [camel][ITU] got its [nose][hooks] into the [tent][internet]
Yaovi Atohou:Sorry that I am disconnected again
avri:i had not need to speak, i thought typed comments was sufficient.
Julia Charvolen:We will dial out to you
Alan Greenberg:On call now.
Carlton Samuels:@Avri: Absolutely!
Alan Greenberg:Where are we in agenda?
Yaovi Atohou:Sorry that I am disconnected again
Olivier Crepin-Leblond:WCIT
Evan Leibovitch:#7

Heidi Ullrich:Avri - I think having a longer conversation is a good idea. This is only the first act
Heidi Ullrich:there are several more events in the next couple of year
