Glenn McKnight 2: (11:57) captioning is cost effective

Renata Aquino Ribeiro: (11:57) Great news to hear that captioning will be in the budget

Glenn McKnight 2: (11:58) Yes it has started to provide a tool for people with special needs but it has been used by everyone

Josh Baulch: (11:59) Currently ICANN spends ~\$1/2 million USD on live captioning

Glenn McKnight 2: (12:00) the next thing is getting ICann to caption their videos which is a legal obligation for all 501c organizations
