Cheryl Langdon-Orr: PARTLY onplemented Brian
Cheryl Langdon-Orr: implemented should read
Garth Bruen: It should be easy to review the questions before taking the survey
Evan Leibovitch: back on audio
Garth Bruen: The first question refers to the ATRT1., but it's not linked.
Garth Bruen: Hard to see how people can give an assessment without quick access to the details
Garth Bruen: Ditto on question 2
Olivier Crepin-Leblond: all details should be linked from the PC page. Perhaps could we have Matt beef up the At-Large PC page, with links to the ATRT1

+ AoC + ATRT2 workspace, + SSR RT report + Whois RT Report?

Garth Bruen:Presenting (as part of the survey) the ATRT1 recommendations FIRST and asking for a 1 - 10 rating on each might provide more guidance and better interest.

Heidi Ullrich:@Olivier, I believe Garth is referring to the actual survey itself

Garth Bruen:It should be simple. Question: "Is this a red square?"

Cheryl Langdon-Orr:I read the latter

Cheryl Langdon-Orr: how well they were implemented we could have comments on the former

Holly Raiche:And isn't it part of the comment process to gauge how well implementation has occurred?

Cheryl Langdon-Orr:Yes it is Holly

Matt Ashtiani:i can have a chat with Olivier and Alan to discuss this issue

Cheryl Langdon-Orr:happy to help Matt

Heidi Ullrich:Is the information being requested not one for the PC itself rather than the At-Large PC workspace?

Heidi Ullrich:If At-Large is requesting more information, wouldn't other communities need the same info?

Cheryl Langdon-Orr:OUT workspace

Cheryl Langdon-Orr:OUR

Garth Bruen:@Brian, first "tool" get someone who has conducted surveys and is trained to draft them. This is actually a VERY specific skill.

Cheryl Langdon-Orr:sorry still dark here

Cheryl Langdon-Orr:indeed it is Garth VERY

Evan Leibovitch:Brian, we will be submitting comments, however the comment that has been authored is rather "over-arching" and may not fit into any specific of the subgroups. I hope that will not impede its ability to be considered by RT members.

Cheryl Langdon-Orr:too late by then Holly

Holly Raiche:Okay - will do a communication sooner - Heidi - maybe a webinar for APRALO?

Brian Cute:Thanks Garth. Got it. Evan, the over-arching comments would be welcome. There will e later opportunities for comments later in the year.

Garth Bruen:The questions are too long. It needs to be something someone can read and then BANG give an opinio on.
